

SALT TAX IN INDIA

There is a general expectation among the natives of India that the coronation of King George at the approaching Durbar at Delhi will bring the announcement of a great royal boon. It is suggested that nothing could be more appropriate than the abolition of the hated salt tax. An anonymous writer in the London "Times," evidently a person of authority, says:— "The saying in the price is not, as Western politicians suppose, the only thing that counts. In Burma the native factories are being openly strangled today, for the benefit of Indian revenue, in a way that has no parallel in English history, except in the distressful chapters that deal with Ireland. In India there are few such factories now left; but as soon as the business is free this pleasant and wholesome old village industry shall revive like grass after the rain along the coast of India and Burma, and wherever in the interior there are wells of brine or veins of salt in the rocks. Their coarse and home-made salt is better for their cattle than the more refined but less aper-

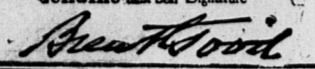
gent article which now has a monopoly. I know well how ill the loss of the salt tax can be afforded by government; but I also know it to be as certain as anything in arithmetic that every pice or farthing gained by it costs the people rupees. It is the most mischievous tax ever invented in an agricultural country, being on a vital requisite of man and beast. A tax on raw materials no tariff tinker would venture to suggest in England; yet it would be hard to think of anything of the kind which could hamper production more than is old is all the more reason for ending it now. It is an old curse."

TIME TABLE FOR BREAD AND CAKES

Bread, large loaves, an hour; small loaves, from half to three-quarters of an hour. Biscuits and rolls, in from 15 to 20 minutes. Brown bread, steamed three hours. Loaves of sponge cake, 45 minutes, if tin, about 30. Loaves of richer cake, from 45 minutes to an hour. Fruit cake, about two hours, if in two or three-pound loaves. Small tin cakes and cookies, from 10 to 15 minutes. Watch carefully. Baked puddings, rice, etc., one hour. Boiled puddings, three hours. Custards to be watched and tested after the first 15 minutes. Batter puddings, baked 45 minutes. Piecrust, about half an hour.
