**Industrial Stocks Mixed At Montreal**

MONTREAL, Dec. 1 (CP)—Selected industrials closed mixed to slightly firmer in moderately active dealings on the stock exchange and curb market here today. An upward trend was distinguishable in mines.  
 Closing index averages indicated banks off .03 to .2876; utilities off .4 to .754; industrials off 1.5 to .269; papers up 3.30 to 385.63. Goids up .21 to 79.95. Volume was approximately 54,000 industrial shares and 130,200 mining shares.  
 Topping paper gains were Consolidated which went ahead 1-2 at 21 on a 2,947-share turnover. Don-lacoac and B. C. Forest, both moderately active, added 1-8 each at 25 1-8 and 4 1-8 respectively.  
 Brown, with a 4,550 share turnover, dropped 1-4 at 6 3-8. Off 1-8 each were Great Lakes and Abitibi Common.  
 Utilities were quiet as Bell went ahead 1-2 on a limited turnover. Southmont pushed ahead a cent at 39. C.P.R. on an expanded turnover of 3,267 shares added 1-3 at 13 1-8. In carriers, Algoma was a feature in lists recovering two points at 54 1-2.  
 With a 10,800 share turnover Imperial rose 1 5-8 cents in oils. Imperial lost 1-4 point at 14 1-2. Walker and Seagrams were active in beverages gaining 3-4 at 26 and 1-2 at 21 1-4 respectively.  
 Other industrial gainers included Industrial Alcohol "A" and Labrador, ahead 40 cents at 715. East Sullivan went up 20 cents at 3.55 and Eldona seven at 1.15. Donalda added three cents, Quebec Manranese two and Quebec Yellowknife one. Down one cent each were Formaque and Goldvue.

**Trend Upward In Quiet Dealings On N. Y. Exchange**

 NEW YORK, Dec. 1 (AP)—Recovery ruled today's stock market in its first December session and, while dealings were relatively slack throughout, the overall average recorded its first advance in almost two weeks.  
 Volume of 800,000 shares compared with 930,000 Friday and 790,000 last Monday.  
 The Associated Press 60-stock composite was up .4 of a point at 642, the first plus sign since Nov. 20.  
 Canadian issues were irregular. Hiram Walker gained 3-4 while McIntyre was up 1-2. Distillers Seagrams added 1-8. Dome Mines was down 1-2 and Canadian Pacific was unquoted.  
 On the Curb, Lake Shore was unquoted and Giant Yellow Knife added 1-8.  
 New highs were touched by Anaconda Wire and Cable, which finished up 1 3-8 at 80 1-2; American Southern Railway 34 3-4; Union Pacific 152 1-4; Douglas Aircraft 46 1-2; Boeing 7-8; American Can 80; Du Pont 188 1-2; Allied Chemical 197 1-2; Owens-Illinois 76 3-4; U. S. Gypsum 108; Mission 120; Warren Petroleum 80 3-8 and Standard Gas 44 Preferred 23 3-4.
