Stage Big War On Rheumatism

LONDON, April 15 — (CP) — Britain is planning a big-scale war on rheumatism. Leader of the fight is 77-year-old Lord Horder, physician to the King. This alert, keen-eyed man believes relief could be brought to millions of Britons suffering from rheumatism and other painful muscular ailments. He planned a flying squad of 200 mobile physiotherapy units, fitted with the most modern electrical equipment, bringing the latest treatment to every small town and village in the country.

Lord Horder's dream has started to come true. Already 20 women, all trained electrical equipment operators, have been travelling Britain for more than a year. In 12 trucks, they have taken their equipment to remote farms and cottages, miles from bus routes and to homes where people were too sick to travel to hospital. Every week they sent reports to Lord Horder, and on them he is basing his new campaign.

He says that the mobile physiotherapy service will expand throughout this year and well into 1948. He hopes to have 200 trucks strategically placed in every centre in the country. There will be two fully-trained physiotherapists to each truck, and all the latest electrical equipment. Lord Horder hopes to have a uniformed service for his war of rheumatism. He says he won't have any difficulty in getting recruits, for there are between 10,000 and 12,000 people in Britain fully trained to handle the necessary equipment. At the moment the staff is all women.

The service's first target is to be able to treat all urgent cases who cannot leave home, and, in time, to serve anyone who needs the treatment. Fifty cents a visit is charged those who are able to pay for the service.
