The elders stood 3 for union and one against; members of congregation two for union, 56 against; adherents to the church, two for union, 54 against. The quarterly board of the Methodist churches in the Salisbury circuit met yesterday afternoon and the vote on church union gave seventeen in favor of union and none against. The board also extended a unanimous call to Rev. J. B. Champion to return as pastor for a second year.—St. John Telegraph. (Rev. Mr. Champion is well known in Charlottetown.)

**AUSTRALIAN PARTIES LAND IN ANTARCTIC ZONE.**

HOBART, Tasmania, March 12.—The ship Aurora, which sailed from this port on Dec. 2 last, with the Australian Antarctic expedition under the leadership of Dr. Douglas Mawson aboard, returned to Hobart today. The Aurora is commanded by Captain J. K. Davis.

She landed two separate parties at two points in the Antarctic regions; one under Dr. Mawson on Jan. 19, and the other under Dr. Wilde, who is a veteran of the Shackleton and Scott marches, on Feb. 19.

The Aurora found no trace of the Clerke coast, from which it is concluded that it was an ice barrier that had broken up since Durville's discovery, 1838. The Aurora left Antarctic on Feb. 21 and will return in the spring.

Some of the best known English explorers are with the parties landed by the Aurora, which muster 25 men in all. The most advanced feature of the equipment is a monoplane in charge of Lieut. Watkins, who has taken part in a number of aviation meets. Speaking of the value of the aeroplane in exploration, Dr. Mawson said, prior to the departure of the expedition:—

"An aeroplane can fly over an ice crevasse or a ridge as easy as over anything else, whereas a party on foot might have to search a long time to pass, and an aeroplane can do a journey of 150 miles in three hours."

Lieut. Ninnis, of the Royal Fusiliers, who is an expert on surveying and sledging; and a Swiss, Dr. Merz, an adept with the skis, are included in the expedition, and Australians and New Zealanders complete the complement.
