**MILK FOR BRITAIN**  
The 100 Kinsmen Clubs in Canada and Newfoundland are united in one gigantic service project—the well-known Milk-for-Britain Campaign. This campaign was begun on the urgent request of the British Ministry of Foods when war conditions had forced the milk ration down to one-third of a pint per day. What a pitiful small ration for a growing child, when we consider that Canadian children drink a full quart or more every day.  
The Kinsmen Clubs have carried on many projects to raise money for this essential war charity. District No. 7 has sent 76,010 quarts of milk already but when we consider that there are ten million children in Britain we realize that the work must be carried on steadily and with increasing effort. Kinsmen are indeed grateful to the general public, who realizing the gravity of the situation, has so generously assisted in this campaign.
