#### SUGGESTIONS FOR REVIEW.

From Joshua to Samuel.—This period was an eventful one in the history of Israel. The people were grieved over the loss of Moses, their great leader and lawgiver. Joshua, however, led them on to the conquest of Canaan. Then followed peace and war in rapid succession. The land had little rest from anxiety and apprehension, though actual wars were not continuous nor often very prolonged. The people of Israel were irascible. They had come out of serfdom and severe bondage. They were growing into a nation. It was slow, hard training them for freedom. The history of this training is of value, since from it can be learned the principle upon which God dealt directly with a nation in these times. While there is some difficulty in applying the same principle to our times, and even some indistinctness of vision in defining the principle itself through the lapse of over thirty centuries, yet the great outlines can be fairly perceived. The people of Israel were a theocracy—the only one known in the history of our race, at least since the flood. Jehovah was Israel's king or ruler. He appointed civil, moral and ceremonial rules for the people. The nation was disciplined, trained, educated, under special divine direction. So far then as we can clearly understand the conditions, circumstances and disposition of the people at any given time, and perceive what Jehovah did for and to them in their environment, we may learn the principle upon which God will deal with us under similar circumstances. This gives an exceptional value to Hebrew history over all other histories; it is a great lesson in religion for us and for all generations.

The law laid down the principles of government, of worship and of personal conduct in a social state. This nation of slaves required long training before they were fitted to live in accord with the rules divinely appointed for them. It required a large exercise of faith in the divine counsel and power. But to this the people were unused, and so they were ever coming into straits through unbelief, and calling down judgments or pleading for deliverance.

This disciplinary schooling was continued with marked emphasis during the turbulent period of the judges, the home life in Canaan being now and then lighted up by such pathetic but peaceful and loving incidents as that of Boaz and Ruth, and by such family piety as that in the home of Hannah and Samuel.

Israel was to be God's kingdom, and to prepare the way for the Redeemer. Weary, sad, long and often disappointing to human wisdom were the preparations; yet the time drew on.

#### LESSONS IN REVIEW.

1. Conquering a Home.—As in Egypt and in this life there is no permanent abiding-place for man. This is the wilderness of sin, where he is under discipline, or on the way to the heavenly land.

The crossing of Jordan was the crisis in the journey, but that alone did not give possession of Canaan. The home must be made, and the place for it must be cleared of foes. The parallel may not be forced too sharply. The reward of faith and fidelity came at last. It would have come much sooner and easier had Israel been true and trusting rather than disloyal and unbelieving. The joys of the kingdom of heaven come to those who come into the spirit of its life and continue therein. They inherit the earth, this life and the life to come. The earth becomes a heaven in foretaste, and the transfer gives no jar, apprehension or alarm. It is the home-call, the home-coming.

11. Training a People.—For generations the experiences of Israel were intended to bring them into the condition of self-government, self-poise and at the same time willingness to obey God and to trust him with an implicit belief.

Gideon was a conspicuous example of one who finally was ready to accept God's promises of deliverance, even when all the forces and powers visible to human sight were against it. Further, he was ready to take measures to reduce his army to a mere corporal's guard, when the enemy mustered thousands of valiant and notable warriors, flushed by the success of many recent victories. Judged by the great generals of his time, the act of Gideon was that of a military lunatic, though the stratagem and tactics shown in disposing of his petty three hundred were worthy of the greatest general in ancient or modern times. The great fact to be borne in mind, as the key to his character and conduct, is that he was only the instrument in Jehovah's hands to teach Israel faith for the race. The exploits of Othniel and Ehud, of Deborah and Barak, of Abimelech and Jephthah, of Samson and of Boaz, are all to be read and interpreted by this one key.

The nation loved show, pageantry, luxury, pomp, great cavalcade and an immense play board with a life of ease. There were mere children; their tastes and pleasures were those common to a race in the state of serfdom.
