Farmers should remember that appearance as well as quality is important. Hogs when killed should be allowed to hang in a cool place for twenty-four hours before being brought to market. Attention to these matters will be to the mutual advantage of farmers and packers.

### Synopsis of Canadian Northwest Land Regulations

THE sole head of a family or any male over eighteen years of age, may homestead a quarter section of available Dominion land in Manitoba, Saskatchewan or Alberta. Applicant must appear in person at the Dominion Lands Agency or Sub-Agency for the District. Entry by proxy may be made at any Dominion Lands Agency, but not Sub-Agency on certain conditions.

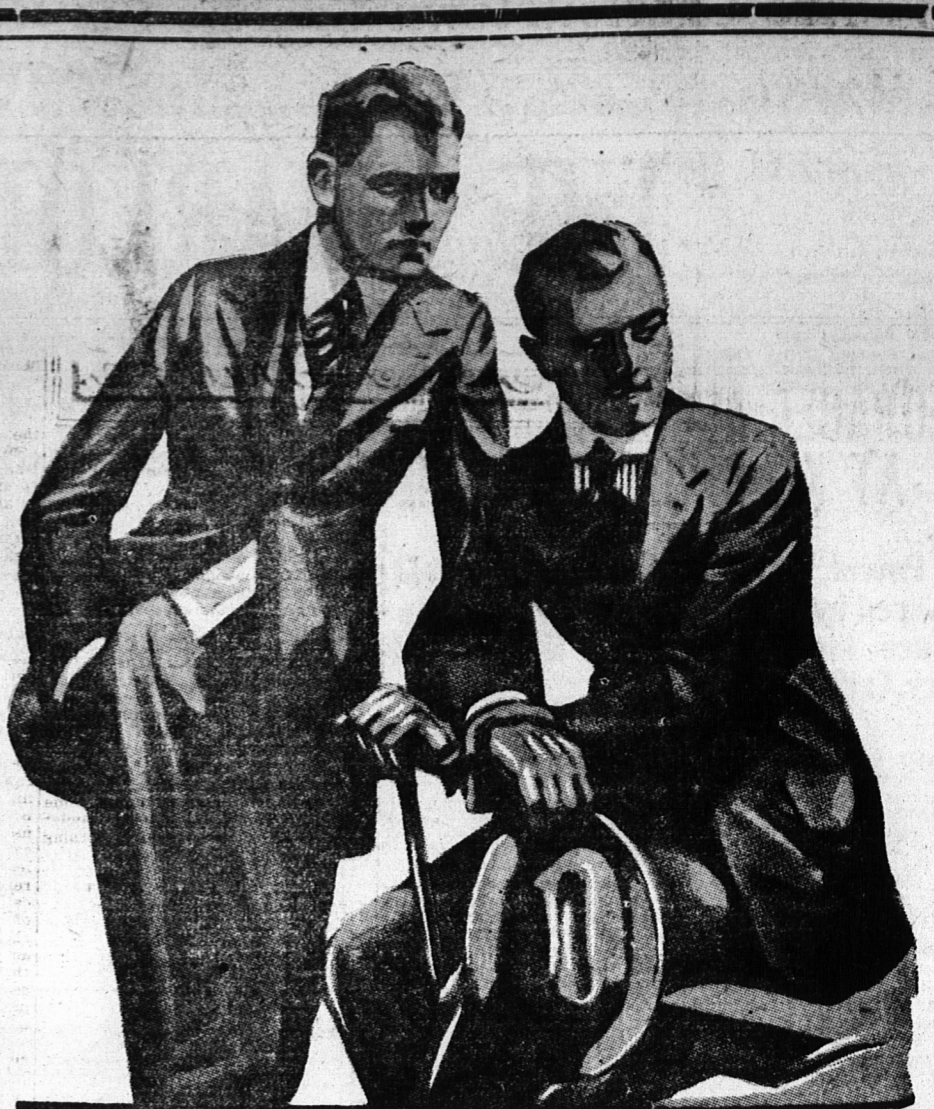
Entry—Six months residence upon and cultivation of the land in each of three years. A homesteader may live within nine miles of his homestead on a farm of at least 20 acres, 50 acres extra cultivation. Pre-emption patent may be obtained as soon as homestead patent, on certain conditions.

A settler who has exhausted his homestead right may take a purchased homestead in certain districts. Price \$1.00 per acre. Pre-emption patent may be obtained as soon as homestead patent, on certain conditions. Must reside six months in each of three years cultivate 50 acres and erect a house worth \$500. The area of cultivation is subject to reduction in case of rough, scrubby or stony land. Live stock may be substituted for cultivation under certain conditions.
