First Ice Races on the Harbour Today

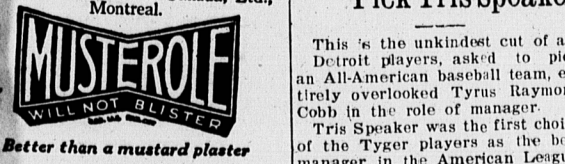
CROWD CHEERED ON NURMI, AS GREAT FINN BROKE WORLD MARKS

NEW YORK, Jan. 9.—When Paavo Nurmi, the Finn, won his first two American races at the Madison Square Garden, setting new world and indoor records for the mile run and the 5,000 metre event. These were the first races he had ever won on an indoor track.

His record for the mile, in which he beat out Jole Ray by five yards, was 4:33 3/5. In the second race he gave a bad beating to Willie Ritola, his countryman, and set up a new indoor mark of 14:44 3/5.

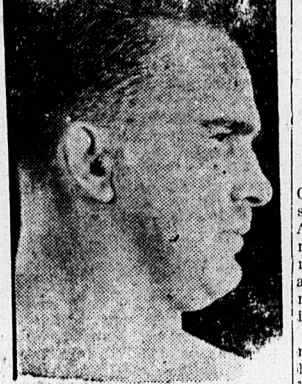
'Sons' Take Game From St. Anns 5-3
