LOUISBURG despatch of July 2nd says:—Earnest Kemp, oyster expert of the Department of Marine and Fisheries, Ottawa, arrived here this morning from Sydney, in company with Dr. Kendall, M. P., and will visit the oyster beds of Mira River and Catalone. The present mission of Mr. Kemp, who has just completed the inspection of the beds at Whycoomagh and Malagawatch, is to examine and report upon all oyster beds in Cape Breton, including those of Mira, Catalone, East Bay and the Bras d'Or Lakes. These beds will be cultivated if the reports are favorable. Mr. Kemp has been very successful in his experiments in the production of oysters. The beds of North River, P. E. I., after being abandoned three years under the supervision of the department, have produced about 2,000 barrels of good oysters in one season. The beds of Shediac, N. B., have also produced good results. The oysters from the beds of New Brunswick and Prince Edward Islands took the gold medal at the Paris Exposition after having to contend with the difficulties of transportation, the passage to Paris occupying three weeks. The deputy minister was highly pleased with the result.
