**Request of P. E. I. Govt. is Opposed**

MONTREAL, July 24—Strong opposition to the request of the Government of Prince Edward Island for a spring shooting season for waterfowl is being registered by the province of Quebec Association for the protection of fish and game, it is stated by E. A. Cartier, general secretary of the association.

The matter is of vital importance not only to the province of Quebec but also to the rest of Canada and all United States. The Migratory Bird Treaty between Canada and the United States was a great step in the interests of conservation of valuable wild life resources. The chief benefit of the treaty was really the abolition of spring shooting, and to resume spring shooting, said Mr. Cartier, would be virtually to abandon the treaty.

**BOARD OF TRADE COUNCIL MEETS**—At a meeting of the Board of Trade Council yesterday afternoon at which Mr. G. J. Tweedy presided, communications were read from the railway authorities indicating that due to certain physical difficulties, it would not be possible to build an overhead bridge in the place of the proposed level crossing near the Tormentine pier. Another letter from the railway authorities stated it was believed that the reduced rates for ferry transportation of automobiles already in force were sufficient, and that no special weekend rates would be offered. A number of members expressed the opinion that existing weekend rates are too high. The report on the entertainment of Mr. W. McL. Clark, Secretary of the Canadian Chamber of Commerce, was received.
