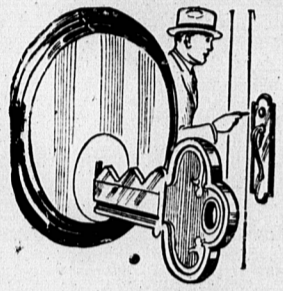

Richly Rewarded By Can. Govt.

OTTAWA, Ont., Nov. 11.—Canadians liquidated an old obligation today when, according to announcement by Hon. Gideon Robertson, acting Minister of the Interior, the sum of \$67,000 was made to Commander Otto Sverdrup, famous Norwegian explorer, in return for the services rendered by him in his explorations and discoveries in the Arctic islands.

The Government of Norway has formally recognized the Canadian title of the Arctic Islands, commonly known as the Sverdrup Group, comprising Axel Seiberger, Ellef Ringnes, Amund Ringnes and King Christian. This friendly action on the part of the Norwegian Government removes the one possible ground of dispute as to Canadian sovereignty in the whole Arctic north of the Canadian mainland.

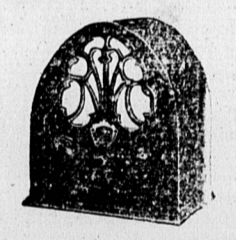
