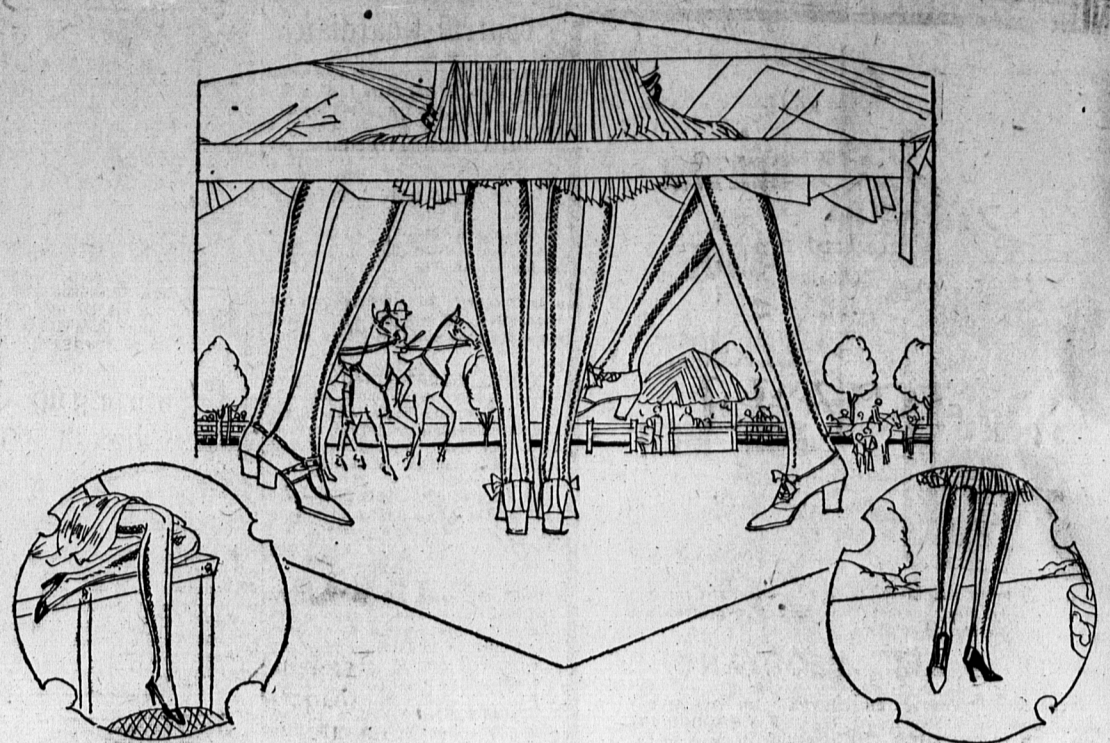

### Commission at Work On Statute Revision

(Special to the Guardian) OTTAWA, June 22.—The commission on statute revision began here yesterday what was designed as its final sittings, but an order that the acts of last session be incorporated makes improbable the conclusion of the work so soon. The statutes have not been revised since 1906, the usual decennial revision having been omitted in war time. The work has been in progress for some time and consists of the consolidation and codification of the different statute or criminal code amendments. The commission consists of Sir Charles Fitzpatrick, R. Cameron, K.C., Registrar of the Supreme

Court, E. J. Daly, Ottawa; L. J. Rivet, K.C., of Montreal; Alex McGregor of Toronto; and F. Med Russell, of Vancouver.
