WINNIPEG, Aug. 3 — (CP) — Trading continued dull on the Winnipeg Grain Exchange today, but the future showed gains of more than one cent a bushel at the close. The export market was neglected, and no sales were reported.

CHICAGO, Aug. 3 — (AP) — Wheat rallied toward the close today, carrying other grains upward on the strength of broker buying, considered as further removal of hedges against cash sales to Mexico. Houses with eastern export connections also have been on the buying side.

At the close wheat was 7-8 to 1-1/4 higher, Sep. 1.66 1/2-%. Corn was unchanged to 1/4 higher, Dec. 1.18 1/2-%. Oats were 3/4 to 1/2 higher, Sep. 65-64 1/2-%. Barley was 1/2 higher, Sep. 1.48 1/2-%. Rye was 1/4 higher to 1-1/4 lower, Sep. 1.14 1/2-%.

MONTREAL, Aug. 3 — (CP) — Junior mines gave another rallying display after two previous sessions of rising prices today on the Stock Exchange and Curb Market, and worked out of a spell of profit-taking. Among the pivotal groups, trends were steady to irregular with strong spots here and there and with volume slim.

East Sullivan and Sullivan, leaders in the upswing in junior mines, continued in that role and others ahead were Donalda, Heva, Aubelle, Macdonald, Standard, Quebec Yellowknife, Pandora, St. Jacques, Kirkland Gold, Century, Beaudor, Brien and Red Cross. Rochette converted a loss into a gain and Centaurque and Arno were also in the lead. Ferron, Goldora and Central Cadillac were losers.

NEW YORK, Aug. 3 — (AP) — In one of the slowest sessions of the past year, stock market leaders generally tilted upward today under leadership of rails.

Transfers of 60,000 shares compared with the smallest for a 5-hour stretch since Sept. 8 last.

The Associated Press 60-stock average was up 3 of a point at 64.7.
