POST OFFICE GENERAL DELIVERY.

Sir,—My letter to you regarding the Post Office general delivery wicket has been forwarded from the Deputy Post Master-General a very courteous letter to me inviting me to communicate with the Department regarding the charges contained in my letter.

Mr Coulter assures me that the Department is most anxious to give efficient service and is bending its energies to do so.

I have written to him thanking him for his assurance that in future, any complaints in regard to the postal service are forwarded to the department they shall be immediately investigated.

I am already acting upon this suggestion.—For the last fortnight I have been absent on the eastern circuit of the Supreme Court and every day my servant boy has looked at the delivery wicket for such of his letters and papers as the clerk will give him. These are taken to the Registrar of the Court of Chancery and the stamps on the envelopes examined, and if it had appeared that any of these letters had been allowed to remain in the office undelivered the envelope together with an affidavit of the facts would at once have been sent to me and by me forwarded to the Department at Ottawa.

As soon as the steamers get clear of the ice I am obliged to go to Montreal for treatment of my eyesight.

During my absence, the same course will be pursued, and proofs of the clerk's objectionable conduct will be forwarded to me and I shall at once proceed to Ottawa and lay them before Mr. Coulter. I am in no sense acting for the general public; my intention is to see that the little lad, who is my servant boy, shall receive fair treatment, and this I am determined on.


