S. A. McDONALD'S GREAT MILLINERY OPENING

Last Night was A Grand Success.

One of the most interesting events of the season are the millinery openings and the one at the new goods store last evening adds another to the successful openings this firm has had.

Last night pronounced the formal opening of the millinery season in this city. It is the first glimpse the ladies of Charlottetown have had of what is to be popular for the incoming season. It was a revelation of all the latest New York, Paris and London models. The display made last evening was much admired by the hundreds who thronged the popular shopping centre of Charlottetown. To attempt to give a description of the many handsome models displayed would require a genius to describe and it would be impossible to give a description on paper.

This firm has made a great hit in the millinery business in this city. Their show last evening forecasts another successful season's selling. Miss Peckwith and her first assistant, Miss Duggan, have demonstrated their ability as milliners in any, are more calculated to require artistic taste and to offer a wider scope for skillful designing, than that of making ladies' hats.

The showing last evening was indeed a blending of good taste, skill and master workmanship. Only words of praise are heard concerning the new styles as they are of such varied character that it would seem that every woman could be suited. Naturally there are certain styled features of the season which are being carried out to a greater or less extent in all of the models but they are shown in such a variety and are of such a pleasing character that there should be little difficulty in fitting becomingly practically every face.

The extreme models are particularly interesting as they embody the features which the leaders of fashion are after and appeal very strongly to the average Canadian woman.

Really none of this season's hats can be called small as the crowns are in most instances so high in style that models, which might otherwise be called small, give the appearance of being large. Facings are invariably noted and are of contrasting colors. Satin hats are faced with Ottoman Silk or vice versa. Another model in which the back trimming was a notable feature was a large black satin hat with a very broad pronounced crown, and the curving slightly down. At the back a great bunch of ostrich plumes fell over the crown and also back over the brim, while under them a mass of loops of black satin ribbon reached just a little below the edge of the brim.

While the large hats are the rule a few very smart smaller ones were exhibited also. One of these, in shape like

an English walking hat, was a continuation of ecru beaver cloth and felt; the brim was felt and over the high wide crown and the edge of the brim the beaver cloth was closely draped. Two tonbons, one ecru and one cerise adorned the left side of the hats.

One of the handsomest of the smaller hats seen was a brown felt, in shape round, with a flat set rolling brim and large dome crown. This was set on a small half vandeau that tilted it up on the left side, and a broad band of fancy silver trimming surrounded the crown. At the right side of the front two large shaded green plumes were handsomely arranged to lay flat along the brim.

In order to give everyone an opportunity of seeing the new styles the firm have decided to continue the display all day today and Saturday afternoon and evening.

FRENCH VESSEL BURNED AT SEA

Pail of Oil Capsizes on the Stove and Crew Barely Escaped.

SYDNEY, Sept. 16.—The schooner Lemille, Capt. Bucher, of the French fishing fleet, was burned to the water's edge at Quero Bank, on Thursday night last. The vessel was riding at anchor when early in the morning a pail of oil was accidentally overturned on the stove. In a few minutes the whole forecastle was in flames. The crew had only time to gather a few clothes and escape in their dories, and were later picked up by the schooner Adventurer, Capt. Leo Authur, who landed them at St. Pierre. The Lemille was out on a second trip and had about 100 quintals of fish, and was owned by Emile Folquet, of St. Pierre. She is partly insured.
