#### QUALIFICATIONS FOR AIRCREW

##### AGE

17½ to 32 years inclusive. Exceptional cases over 32, but not over 34, are accepted for Air Crew. Candidates for Air Gunners may be accepted up to 39 years.

##### EDUCATION

No standard is laid down. Those suitable for enlistment, but lacking sufficient education and able to absorb training quickly, are given the necessary academic training after enlistment. Lack of High School education is no longer a bar to enlistment.
