SUNDAY SCHOOL LESSON

JUNE 14.

THE FRIENDS OF SINNERS.

LESSON. Luke xviii. 9-14; xix. 1-10.

"And when Jesus heard it, He saith unto them, They that are whole have no need of a physician, but they that are sick: I came not to call the righteous, but sinners."

THE NARRATIVE.

Our lesson today consists of two paragraphs, the one containing a parable, and the other a story, both of them most familiar. They are united by the revelation they give of Christ as the Friend of sinners. The parable of the Pharisee and the publican was spoken directly to certain who trusted in themselves that they were righteous, and set all others at naught. The Lord took of this particular class and put him in contrast with one of those whom he despised, in words of the simplest nature, presenting a picture that was perfectly familiar at the time, and which in essential matters is as familiar today. The falseness of human standards is revealed, and the judgement of heaven declared.

In describing the Pharisee our Lord used a phrase which in itself was most revealing, as He said that he "prayed with himself." Conspicuously withdrawing himself from association with his fellowmen, this man prayed with himself. That withdrawal was also a withdrawal from association with God. He prayed with himself. It is an almost appalling picture of the awful loneliness of the man who trusts in himself. The description, moreover, is justified by the prayer that he offered. Seeing that it was supposed to be prayer,

so excluded all other men, but included God. Within the circle of that swift sentence God and a man are shut up together. The man, burdened with a sense of his sin, casts himself upon the mercy of God. There was no trust in himself and no content for his fellow-men, but a straight, earnest, passionate abandonment of himself and his need to God.

The verdict of Jesus was clear, calm, and conclusive. This man was justified. This, then, is the true way to God. The story is that of Zacchaeus; the chief publican. It is wholly one of Christ's seeking of a man. There is no suggestion on the part of Luke that Zacchaeus was seeking Jesus at all. Indeed, the evangelist is careful to tell us that he was of little stature, and that his climbing of the sycamore tree was in order to see who it was that was at the centre of the crowd. It must have been to his utter amazement that Jesus named him, and with the authority of the King, and the perfection of friendliness, commanded his hospitality.

What took place within the house we cannot tell. Our Lord's entrance violated all the traditions of the Pharisees. They felt that to accept the hospitality of such a man was either a revelation of our Lord's ignorance of his character, or of His carelessness concerning those things which were necessary to be maintenance of His own character. Leaving them to their wonderings, Jesus dealt with this man. If we do not know what He said to him, we do not know the result, for Zacchaeus openly declared his intention to give half his goods to the poor, and to restore
