### THE CANAL TREATY.

Hon David Mills' article in the Empire Review before referred to in these columns is attracting a good deal of attention in the American press. It has to do with the pending canal treaty, the Monroe Doctrine and the relations of the United States and Canada. Mr. Mills takes the ground that our neighbors are unreasonably grasping and Britain too willing to make concessions. They have taken possession of Dyea and Skagway, thus shutting in the Canadian Yukon, and refuse to arbitrate upon Canada's just claims in that quarter. At the same time, Britain proposes, without consideration, to concede to the States full control of the canal across the Isthmus of Panama, with the right to fortify it.

Thus the United States under the Monroe Doctrine claims a certain control over North and South America, has already shut in the Yukon District and Britain is disposed to concede to the same "ambitious and not over-scrupulous state" the right to erect fortifications upon a great international water way and take possession of it. We feel that Mr. Mills is right in making his protest. The proposed canal concessions ought not to be made without at least a proviso that the Alaska boundary question shall go to arbitration. There is undoubtedly too much disposition on the part of the Imperial authorities to make ill-considered and sometimes unreasonable concessions to Washington.

The Patriot's intimation that the Legislature may not endorse the disqualification of the electors as recommended by the Judge in the Bruce McKinnon election, foreshadows a possible attempt to overthrow a judicial decision by the action of a party majority. Should this be attempted it would afford another evidence of the baneful and dangerous effects of partyism run mad. And when some time in the future, the Conservative party came into power with such a party precedent already laid down, would not they too apply the party white wash brush to any Conservative electors who might be in danger of disqualification? We have reached a sad state of decadence if the decisions of the Judges of the land are to be overturned and set aside for purely partisan reasons.

### AN AGED SHIP FOUND.

Another Viking ship has been found impeded in the mud of the harbor off the Hanse town of Wisby, in the Swedish island of Gothland. The vessel is exceedingly well preserved, in spite of its antiquity. It was found under the quay built in the 11th century, and is of remarkable construction, wooden nails showing a manner of fixing boards now unknown.


