United Kingdom purchases totalled \$12,055,826, and Canada came third with \$8,294,406. A revival of certain former markets is shown. Shipments to Jamaica totalled \$1,584,718 against a blank in 1944-45. Greece, shown as having purchased nothing in the previous year, in 1944-45 took produce to the value of \$1,390,197. Trade with Portugal increased from \$2,300,844 to \$3,468,789, and with Brazil from \$20,010 to \$38,817.
