PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH AND SOCIAL PROBLEMS

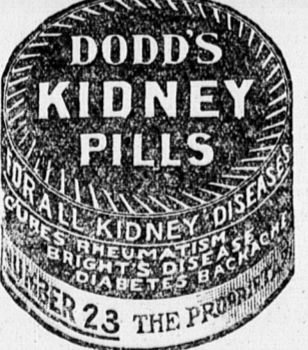
TORONTO, April 17.—In his address to the London, Ontario, Trades and Labor Council, Rev. J. Gibson Inkster, of the First Presbyterian Church, enumerated some causes of the present Presbyterian Confession of Faith on social problems. This new creed was prepared at a meeting of the Social and Moral Reform Board held in Toronto last week. It will be presented to the General Assembly when it meets in Ottawa in July, and will be then the subject of discussion. If it is accepted it places the Presbyterian Church strongly behind those who are fighting the battle of the laboring interests.

Christian spirit in the attitude of society toward offenders against the law. The Church holds that a Christian society must seek the reformation of offenders, and that it must endeavor to prevent the commission of crimes by furnishing a wholesome environment, and by such education and corrective measures as will develop moral sense and individual efficiency in the young. (14) For opposition to vice. We believe that the law of the land should vigorously combat the views of drink, gambling, lust and the abuse of narcotics, and that it is the duty of society to discover and remove the causes of vice. (15) For pure food and drugs. We believe that foods and medicines should be so inspected as to guarantee their freedom from adulteration, poisons and infection. (16) For wholesome recreation. We believe that the play of children and the amusements of adults are of great importance to morals, and that they should be brought under social control, so as to free them from the evil effects of unrestrained commercialism, and make them minister to the physical and moral well-being of the people.

Over these employees they evidently intend to hold the "big stick" and inform them who they are to vote for. Some of our Liberals who are opposing the ballot vote, say, look at all the investigations and scandals which take place under the ballot system. But in reply to that I hold it is far better to have investigations, etc., than to tolerate the bribery and corruption which was carried on (in some cases by high officials) in the last bye-election, and the elected member to be allowed to take his seat. If the Liberal party in this Province feel that they are hanging onto power by the skin of their teeth—and their employees' vote—then it is time to hand over the reins of Government to others, first accepting any Judgeships, Senatorships, etc., that may be dangling in the air almost rusty from want of care, waiting until the Government is "good and ready" to make the appointment.

KISSING SPRITE LATEST PSYCHIC PHENOMENON

BOSTON, April 18.—A spirit kiss given through a newly discovered psychic medium is the most striking thing discussed by Dr. James H. Hyslop, formerly a professor at Columbia and now with the Society for Psychical Research, in the latest report of the Society, of which a synopsis is published today. Dr. Hyslop contends that this medium, an uneducated country girl living in a little Southern town, has added some new phenomena to the records of the Society. The subject, whom he calls Miss Burton, although that is not her real name, developed her power at home and under the guidance of her foster mother. She has never given séances for money. In his investigations Dr. Hyslop was assisted by two physicians and some of the phenomena witnessed are set forth in the report as follows: "Some of the incidents in the subject's experience are the orthodox psychical phenomena, such as raps, levitation of the table, rope tying and movements of the tambourine. Others are more unique, such as trance whistling of an expert type and simultaneous singing, and starting and stopping of a phonograph. Automatic writing and clairvoyant visions, with occasional automatic speech, also characterizes the case. In this respect it is much richer in variety of phenomena than the case of Miss Burton. In color and local illumination they were like the lights of fireflies, but did not illuminate the adjacent space so readily or clearly.
