NEW YORK, June 16—International news this morning is better but domestic news is still unfavorable. The French government won a vote of confidence in the House of Deputies yesterday by a vote of 346 to 247 to give to the government authority for raising \$9,000,000 new capital and satisfying bondholders and shareholders claims as follows:—for each \$1,000 and arrears \$600, new first mortgage bonds \$700 new second mortgage bonds, \$400, fractional bond warrants, \$1,000 exchangeable for new second mortgage bonds on basis of \$100 bond for ten such warrants and 1.25 in cash. Seven percent pd. to receive 5 new common and six percent pd. to receive 4 1-2 new common shares. Holders of each common share receive one fifth share new common and warrant to purchase new common on the basis of 3 new common shares for each 10 shares held at price of \$25 within first year, \$30 within two years and \$35 within three years.

MONTREAL, June 16—(CP)—Montreal Stock Exchange listings tended fractionally lower today in extremely dull trading.

Metals displayed steadiness but on other divisions, losses lent a touch of easiness to the list. A few shares of Bank of Montreal went down 3 1-2 points for the top loss of the day.

Papers generally were lower, Bathurst holding unchanged at 18 and St. Lawrence Corp. preferred gaining 1-4.

A couple of small-selling constructions held steady but the active issues lost ground, Dominion Steel rising 7-8 to 17 1-2, Canada Cement 1-4 to 16 1-4 while odd lots of Dominion Bridge sold 1-4 lower at 48 3-4.

Among utilities, Shawinigan and Montreal each gained 1-4, and in rails, Canada Car lost 1-8 to 16 and C.P.R. 1-4 to 12 3-4.

MONTREAL, June 16—(C.P.)—Imported potatoes dropped 25 cents on Montreal open produce markets today while butter, eggs and cheese held steady.

Graded egg shipments in cartons or less were quoted at 20 1-2 to 21 1-2 cents a dozen for grade A-large, 19 1-2 for A-medium, 19 for grade B and 18 for C.

Butter was quoted at 25-25 1-4 cents a pound for cartons or less of No. 1 while lots to retailers were 26 for solids and 26 1-2 for prints.

Cheese was quoted at 15 1-4 cents a pound for Ontario white Quebec were 14 3-4.

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Mining

TORONTO, June 16—Mining shares continued the downward drift on the Toronto market today, the golds losing about a point in the index and the base metals showing lesser losses. The list outside the golds was held to an even average by a sizable advance in the western oils.

In the oils Home set the pace with a trade of 21,000 shares and an advance of 15 cents to 2.50. Okalta, Vulcan and Dalhousie held the same gain on lighter turnover. Nearly all the cheaper issues were up 1 to 4 cents and Royalite posted an advance of 2 1-4 to 43 1-2.

A steady to strong tone ruled in the senior gold group while the secondary issues were irregular and the penny issue weak. Lake Shore added 3-8, Dome a point and McIntyre and Hollinger were unchanged. Losses of 5 to 10 cents were boarded for Anglo-Huronian, Central Patricia, Kerr-Addison, Macassa, O'Brien, Pickle Crow, Siscoe and Sladen. Little Long Lake lost 1-2.

Penny golds to slip off 3 to 6 cents under moderate selling were Bidgood-Kirkland, Dorval - Siscoe, Gold Belt, Morris-Kirkland, Paymaster, Perron, Red Lake, Shawkey and Temiskaming. Darkwater was offered down 13 cents to 35, Preston 8 to 82 and Gunnar 12 to 56, all at new lows for the year.

Base metal shares were heavy despite higher London metal prices. Noranda weakened 1 5-8, Ventures 40 cents and Normetal 5 cents. Silvers were quiet and steady.
