LONDON, Jan. 26.—Nothing is creating more interest in England at the present time than the revival of the proposal to construct a tunnel across the British Channel to connect England with France. This is, of course, not by any means the first proposal of the kind. About the year 1830, before there were locomotives of gas, M. Mathieu, a French engineer, proposed a coach road tunnel lighted with oil lamps.

A SENSATIONAL CASE IS NOW ON IN SYDNEY C.B.

Constable Swore That Dr Rice Had Performed an Operation

Sydney, Jan. 26.—The preliminary hearing in the Cora McKinnon case was opened before Stipendiary W. H. Horn this afternoon. After a tilt between the counsel for the defence and the Magistrate, in which the former was practically threatened with arrest, the first witness, Jennie Fowler, was called. She testified that she knew the accused, who stayed at the Alton Hotel with her. The accused told her she was in trouble, and that an operation had been performed.

Constable Edwards swore that the girl after her arrest and being cautioned told him that two months after the inception of the trouble she had an operation performed on her by Dr. Rice, at the house of Mrs. Reid, Assby. Counsel for the defence questioned this evidence, as caution had not been given immediately after the girl's arrest.
