THE VAUDEVILLE PROGRAM FOR THE DOMINION EXHIBITION

Splendid Attractions Have Been Secured—Great Improvements Being Effected on The Grounds and in The Buildings

Manager Hall is back from New York having arranged for a splendid list of attractions for the Grand Stand performance at the Dominion Exhibition which is not more than six or seven weeks distant. The Exhibition's Vaudeville program will be novel, interesting and exciting, suited to hold the excited attention of the 8,000 spectators whom the enlarged Grand Stand will accommodate. The night performance will conclude with the pyrotechnic spectacle "The Carnival of Venice."

The great drawing card in the afternoon for grand stand patrons will be the horse races. At this race meeting the fleetest field of horses ever brought together in Eastern Canada will compete for valuable purses on nine days and probably also on a tenth day. The Hall on September 10th.

The Exhibition grounds are being so changed and improved for the Dominion Exhibition that those who have been coming to the provincial fairs will hardly know them when they visit Halifax between September 22nd and October 5th. The addition of the splendid Fisheries Building, which has just been completed,

the erection of the Administration Building, which has started, constitute chief features in the improvements. The new buildings this year and those erected last season are a splendid array of departmental structures. Machinery Hall and the Main building are being vastly increased in size. A large addition will be made to the Poultry building and the live stock accommodation, in addition to that for horses, will be greatly increased.

The enclosure within the half mile track has been largely filled in, graded, sown with grass seed and unsightly buildings upon it removed. Within the area will be found ample and convenient accommodation for horses and cattle judging rings, a vaudeville stage with dressing rooms beneath, and an area for the use of owners of horses competing in the big race meeting.

The forthcoming Dominion Exhibition will mark the end of the first decade of the use of these grounds as a means of demonstrating the advancement made in the resources and industry of this part of the Dominion, and this Autumn it will be found that the change and improvement effected is little less than wonderful.

SPLendid "FRISCO PICTURES" IRELAND'S DESIRE TO BE REALIZED

(So says the Halifax Recorder) With reference to Miles Bros., moving pictures of the San Francisco Disaster which commence a two nights engagement at the Opera House to night, the Halifax Recorder says:—The Academy contained a large audience last evening when Miles Bros. pictures of the San Francisco disaster were presented and immensely appreciated.

It is a most interesting entertainment, and no better conception of the great damage by the California Earthquake could be had than by a view of these pictures. They show San Francisco before the disaster, with its beautiful buildings, and then the great destruction wrought, the magnificent houses, the tall public and mercantile structures in ruins, the dynamiting of the buildings, the bread line, the camp of refugees, etc. Every picture is interesting, and made more so by the brief description of each by the lecturer, Leonard J. Mack.

There are also shown a large number of miscellaneous views, many of them humorous, never seen here before. Most of them are the latest moving pictures, imported from Paris. There will be new pictures introduced at each of the remaining performances this and to-morrow evenings, and Saturday afternoon. They are certainly a novelty, and are well worth seeing.

NEW LOCOMOTIVES FOR GRAND TRUNK.

The Grand Trunk Railway system has recently purchased a number of new ten-wheel engines for passenger service from the Locomotive and Machine Co., of Montreal, and the American Locomotive Co., of Schenectady, ten engines being built at Longue Pointe and ten at Schenectady.

These engines will be distributed to different divisions of the system. They are built after the standard type used on this road, but have simple cylinders, 10 in. diameter x 26 in. stroke, with driving wheels 72 in. diameter, boiler pressure 210 lbs. per square inch, tender tank capacity 6,000 U. S. gallons. The weight of engine loaded is 135,000 lbs. So far these engines have given excellent service being placed on trains making very fast time. These engines are quickly becoming popular with the men on the road, as they will handle an ordinary sized passenger train without any difficulty and keep time.
