The following clippings, taken from the St. John Telegraph, will be read with interest in this Province, as it refers to the tourist traffic, which seems to have fallen off this season. "With everything to stimulate tourist traffic, excellent service by water rail, together with extremely warm weather in the United States, the travel this year, up to the present, has but held its own, or shown, possibly, a slight increase. The sum and substance of this season's information furnished by those who have to do with the business. All, however, look to the Dominion Exhibition to pull things together and bring out the season a fairly good one. With reference to travel on the railways, L. R. Ross, terminal superintendent, says that while the suburban traffic has increased to an unprecedented extent, tourist travel is not nearly so large, though the month of July was an exceptionally large one for the Union depot. The bulk of the business, in fact, was done in that month. Mr. Ross said that he was unable to account for this, with a daily boat service as given by the eastern line. He suggested that the direct service to Yarmouth and Digby might have something to do with it, as he understood that Nova Scotia was crowded with tourists. Both Mr. G. Lee, agent for the Eastern Steamship Company here, and Le Baron Thompson, travelling passenger agent for the line, said that the travel here was but holding its own, with only a slight increase. They were unable to account for this state of affairs with the present excellent daily service of the line. They hoped for better conditions during the coming three or four weeks, and Mr. Thompson expressed the opinion that the Dominion Exhibition would bring many who had been holding off for the big attraction."
