 CHICAGO, March 31.—(AP)—The new government feed grain order generally was about what most brokers expected but they still death somewhat timidly in the futures market Saturday, awaiting additional developments in Washington.  
 Scattered offerings of oats found a slow demand most of the time Saturday, but fairly active buying of rye held prices of the grain within narrow fluctuations and had some effect in steadying oats.  
 WINNIPEG, March 31.—(CP)—October rye scored a modest gain while the nearby months of May and July posted losses yesterday in light trading on the Winnipeg Grain Exchange.  
 At the close prices were 3-8 to 2-3-4 cents a bushel lower with May at \$2.43 3-4; July \$2.30, and Oct. \$1.94 3-4.  
 In the export wheat market, the United Kingdom took a cargo of about 300,000 bushels, bringing exports for the week to around 8,000,000 bushels in the form of wheat and flour.
