

GERMANY IS ASKING TOO MUCH

France Not Likely to Accept Moroccan Proposals. Britain Orders Artillery Ready.

LONDON, Sept. 11.—Following the announcement that Germany's counter proposals in the case of the Morocco dispute have been received by the French Government, the French ambassador to the Court of St. James, Mons. Paul Cambon, left hurriedly for Paris yesterday.

The consensus of opinion of the English press is that the negotiations between France and Germany are still at a critical stage and that the time has come for cool-headed reasoning both in Berlin and Paris. As there is plenty of scope for trouble over the question of German economic privileges in Morocco, Germany and France are both adjured to remember that they stand pledged before Europe to maintain the principle of the "open door" and "equal opportunities."

EUROPEAN SITUATION FRANCE AND GERMANY PARIS, Sept. 13.—A meeting of the Cabinet was held yesterday to consider France's reply to Germany's counter-proposals in the Moroccan negotiations.

It is understood that the Cabinet fully approved reply prepared by M. DeSelves. It pays particular attention to the necessity of maintaining commercial equality for all, and of an assurance to France of an absolute free hand, politically, in Morocco.

Other points, the note says, are raised by the German response which are equally serious. The negotiations between France and Germany, the note says in conclusion, probably will be prolonged for some time.

Although the tone of the Paris Bourse was heavy to-day, the solid structure of French finance was little affected by financial embarrassments in Germany, for the reason that the French buy securities for permanent investment, and do not sell them because of a fluctuation in quotations.

The worst effect of the Moroccan question is upon business, which simply waits day by day to see what happens. French houses have cancelled many buying orders in Germany, and the French banks, as previously indicated, refuse to renew the German loans falling due.

Credit likewise is cut off from Berlin in London. The Societe Generale, one of the most important of the French banks, has refused to renew a loan of \$5,000,000 francs (approximately \$1,200,000) made to the Deutch Bank. It was M. Dorizon, manager of Societe Generale, who was utilized by the French Embassy in Berlin to bring Germany's answer to France's proposals concerning Morocco to the French office. He happened to be in Berlin last Friday.
