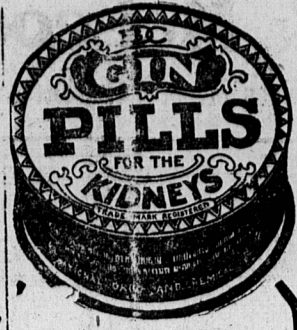

SAXONIA GOING TO GERMANY The Cunard liner Saxonia will sail from New York February 21 for Plymouth, England and Hamburg, Germany, with passengers and cargo. This will be the first time, it is said a Cunard liner ever has gone into a German port.

SHIPBUILDERS TURNING TO LUNENBURG. The Bridgetown Monitor says: The shipbuilders of Bellevue Cove have relaxed in their building operations and are now turning attention to lumbering pursuits. Owners of the Margo Mills, situated some distance inland, have a large gang of men in the woods and it is expected their cut for the coming season will exceed 1,000,000 feet. A good proportion of that will be steamed to Bellevue's Cove for shipment by rail while the greater part will be taken to the wharves for shipment to the United States, West Indies and other markets.
