Rumored U. S.-Canada Power Project Near

OTTAWA, Sept. 20.—(CP)—Spurred on by demands for power engendered by unprecedented wartime industrial expansion, Canada and the United States are reported to be moving close to agreement on the joint power development phase of the Great Lakes-St. Lawrence seaways project.

This development, as contemplated in the general seaways project which was the subject of a treaty signed in 1932, would provide about 2,200,000 horsepower equally divided between Ontario and New York State. The 1932 treaty failed to obtain sanction of the United States Senate.

Before the war brought on the pressing demand for power it was argued that the power and navigation aims of the project should be developed together so that the cost burden could be divided. The new proposal, no doubt, will entail many changes in the financial set-up.
