One of these requires a board or a box that can be tilted up against the ground. On his reclining surface three square openings should be cut, one below the other and each one a little larger than the other. The players should stand with their toes against a line about four feet away from the board—or farther, depending upon the size and skill of the players—and each takes turns tossing the bean bag into the openings in the board. These are marked for scoring—the largest opening counts five, the next ten, and the smallest, and therefore the most difficult opening, fifteen. If the bag is tossed into the hole the player has that score to his credit. At the end of the game the player with the highest score is the winner.

### Two Interesting Games

Every boy and girl likes a bean bag to play with. There are lots of variations of the old game of catch and

the empty tin can. A can is placed on "base" by the player who is it. One of the other players gives it a kick—the object is to kick it as far away as possible—and while he is running after the can, recovering it and replacing it on "base," the players get themselves safely hidden from sight. The rest of the game proceeds as hide and seek, but the can on "base" must be touched every time another player is spied.
