## THE SHIPBUILDING OF THE WORLD DURING THE YEAR 1903

Last Year's Record of World's New Vessels Shows an In-  
crease Over the Preceding Year.

WASHINGTON, March 1.—Frank W. Mahle, United States consul in Nottingham, England, was forwarded to the department of commerce and labor interesting figures of the world's shipbuilding in 1903. He says:

"According to published statistics of last year's shipbuilding, the number of vessels launched in the whole world was 2,441, with a tonnage of 2,079,531 and an indicated horse power of 2,352,485. For 1902 the number of vessels launched was 2,394 with a tonnage of 2,715,670 and an indicated horse power of 2,017,354.

"More than one-half the new tonnage of 1903 was produced within the United Kingdom, England turning out 871 vessels of 766,265 tons, Scotland 362 vessels of

481,833 tons and Ireland 25 vessels of 158,482 tons.

"With the exception of the United States, no foreign country launched an aggregate tonnage equal to the Clyde alone, which built during the year 277 vessels of 446,869 tons. The statistics show that there were decreases on the Clyde, Tay, the Dee the Tyne, the Wear, the Tees, the Humber, the English Channel, in the colonies, the United States, Russia, Germany, France and Holland, and increases on the Forth, the Mersey, the Humber, the English Channel, in the colonies, the United States, Russia, Norway and Sweden, Italy, Austria, Hungary, Japan, Denmark, Belgium and China. The Clyde decrease was not so serious as expected, last year being a record year."

## G. T. PACIFIC WILL RUN FURTHER NORTH

Important Change Proposed Siding Line North of the  
Abitibi.

TORONTO, March 4.—It is understood that the surveyors who are working on the route of the Grand Trunk Pacific have recently changed their recommendations with regard to the route through Ontario and that the railway will now likely pass north of Lake Abitibi instead of south of it, as has been the expectation heretofore. The change it is said, has been caused by the conditions in Quebec Province, where there is considerable rough country. The upper valley of the St. Maurice, the large tributary of the St. Lawrence which empties at Three Rivers, will probably be followed, and this will point the line north of Lake Abitibi.

This change will necessitate a further extension of the Ontario Government's Temiskaming Railway. Maps recently laid on the table of the House have shown the railways meeting at the junctures of the Black and Abitibi Rivers; south of Lake Abitibi, but the actual meeting-place will probably be 40 or 50 miles beyond this point. The country north of Lake Abitibi in Ontario is considered quite as good as that south of it, and the more northerly location of the road is considered to be advantageous to the Province in opening up a large territory and in crossing the James Bay basin at a point which will permit of greater use being made by industries of the streams than if they were crossed nearer their heads.

## THE UNITED STATES AND ENGLANDS TO SMASH RECORDS

A Test Between the Warships of the Two Great Nations—In-  
terested in the Outcome.

WASHINGTON, March 5.—The navy department has advised of the departure from Guantanamo for Pensacola of the North Atlantic squadron, which having practically terminated the winter manoeuvres in the vicinity of Cuba, will engage in target practice on arrival at Pensacola.

An interesting feature in connection with the northward movement is the fact that the battleship squadron is destined for an early journey to the Mediterranean without coming north to the navy yards. The Squadron will stop first at the Azores thus making an endurance test. The navy department has paid particular attention to the cruise of the Asiatic fleet from Yokohama to Honolulu and return and it has been decided to send the battleship squadron of the North Atlantic fleet on a similar journey across the Atlantic. After arriving in the Mediterranean it is now the intention to withdraw two of the battleships to supercede the cruisers Brooklyn and San Francisco, now en route to the United States.

About the time that the American squadron makes its flying trip to the Mediterranean it is learned here that the British admiralty will send over its North American squadron.

Naval officers were interested in the outcome, as it is believed that both squadrons will vie with each other in the endeavor to smash the long distance ocean records for men-of-war.
