CURRENT TARTS ARE SUBSTITUTE FOR MINCE PIE

These form an excellent substitute for mince pie for those who cannot digest the latter. Cover half a pound of currants with boiling water and leave to soak until they are plump, then drain on a hair sieve and dry them in a cloth. Chop a pound of cooking apples. Chop and mix with the currants, add 1-2 cup of soft brown sugar, half a teaspoonful cinnamon, and 4 tablespoonfuls of melted butter. Make some short crust in the usual way. Roll out and line patty tins with it. Put in the currant mixture, put on the lids, cut slits in the centres and bake in a fairly hot oven for about twenty-five minutes until the pastry is well cooked.
