Strong Appeal By Mr. McPhee To King's Electors

Mr. H. Francis McPhee, K.C., Progressive Conservative candidate for King's County, made a strong appeal on behalf of the policies enunciated by the Honorable John Bracken in an address delivered last night. Highlights from Mr. McPhee's speech follow:

"After almost six long years of war we have triumphed over Germany and all our enemies except Japan, and as to that country, we can see complete and certain victory close at hand. While we think with sorrow and gratitude of those of our brave sons who will never return, we look forward with impatient eagerness to welcoming home those heroic men and women whose labors and courage and self-sacrifice have made our victory possible; and each of us is determined that he will do his part and that our new Government must do its part to make of Canada a nation worthy of the sacrifices which have been made on her behalf.

"It is in this mood and spirit and with a full knowledge of the pressing gravity of the national and provincial problems that we must make our decisions as to our policy on election day.

"First in importance are Canada's plans for the re-establishment of our young men and women returning to civil life from the armed and auxiliary services. All of us, irrespective of Party, these plans shall be framed and administered with a generosity and liberality commensurate with Canada's great debt to these men and women. I hope to have an opportunity later of dealing in detail with this most important matter. Other than us are most keenly interested here are those who are directly affected by our own Province and our own people and more especially our own particular constituency. Agriculture and the fisheries, our primary industries and the economic well-being of each one of us, whatever his occupation, are directly dependent upon the economic well-being of these primary producers. Our farmers and fishermen are prosperous, that prosperity reflects itself in the prosperity of each one of us, and the reverse of that proposition is equally true. We require, therefore, the implementation of Federal policies which will benefit our farmers and fishermen the majority of operating at a fair profit, which will give them leisure and a standard of living at least as great as that which our fellow citizens enjoy, and which will divert to them their proportionate share of the national income of Canada.

Transportation

"Intimately connected with this same question is the matter of transportation. This involves the fulfillment of the Federal obligation to the mainland; that is, adequate in the light of modern standards and possibilities. It involves also, the provision of adequate railway service, the improvement and utilization of the splendid natural harbors, and the fullest possible development of transport by air.

"These are only a few of the matters of provincial concern here within the field of Federal policy, but they are among the most important and are sufficient for the comparison which we wish to make. As to these, let us consider what are the policies of the two major Parties.

"The King Government has been continually in power with one five-year break for almost a quarter of a century, and its policy, or lack of policy in reference to these matters can best be learned from its record during that time. What was the record? The farmers and the fishermen know the answer in reference to their own situation. They know that it took a world war to rescue them partially from the bankruptcy into which their industries had been allowed to fall and they know that even now with the world to feed, and with wartime demands at their peak, they are not receiving anything like their proportionate share of our national income.

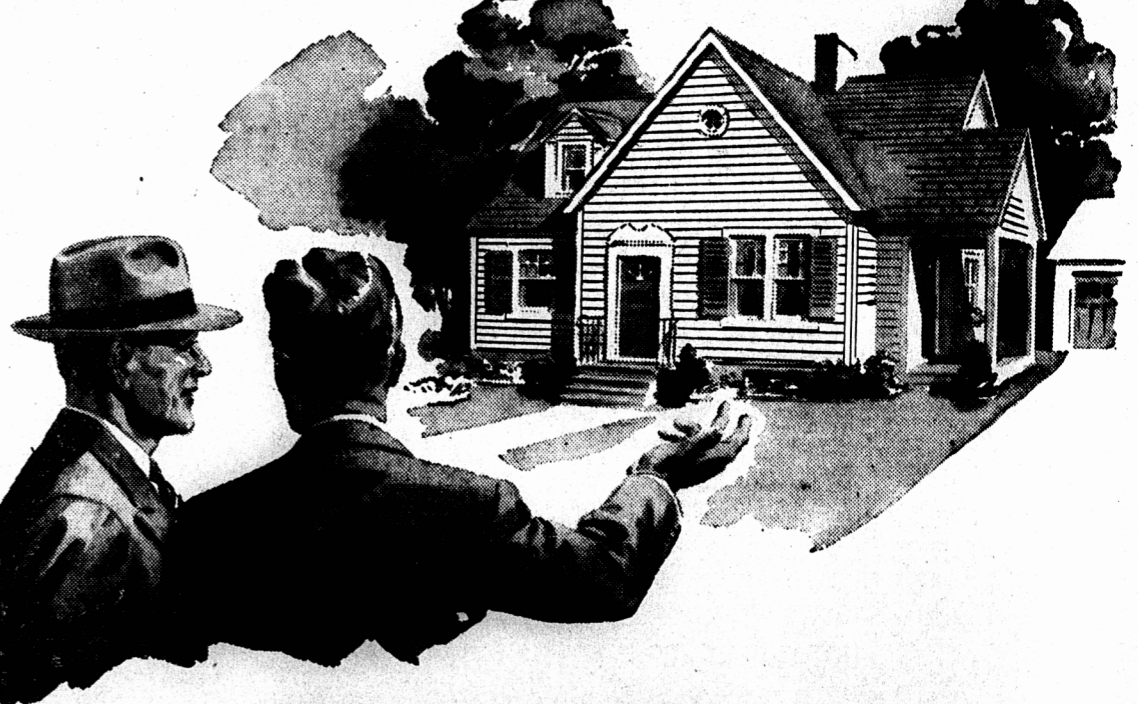
"The record is no better in reference to the other matters to which I have referred. As to transportation, we know that good luck only, in recent winters, has maintained for us the slim thread of our ferry communication, with the mainland; we know that inadequate facilities have annually brought severe losses to our farmers and exporters; we know that our railway services are primitive in comparison with the mainland standard, and that our splendid harbors are permitted to lie idle.
