Viscount Grey's Appeal

For League of Nations To Crush Out Militarism

AMONG the statesmen of the world no one speaks with more authority on the issues of the war or is heard with greater respect in all countries than Viscount Grey of Folloden. His great prestige as the British Foreign Secretary who held the threads of European diplomacy and would have woven them into a lasting peace agreement if they had not been cut by the German sword, has been raised still higher by the Lichnowsky revelations. Though out of office, no man in the Chancelleries of Europe has more real influence—a proof of the power of character. His publication of a pamphlet on "The League of Nations" is therefore an event of international importance.

German people renounce their belief in force and displace the military party and their policy and ideals from power, there can be no league of nations in the sense intended by President Wilson.

The economic pressure would in itself be very powerful, and the action of some of the smaller states composed of the other Entente nations respond? Viscount Grey thinks they will. But Germany must accept it in good faith, and her word cannot be taken so long as military rule continues. He adds:

"The only conclusion is that the United States and the Allies cannot save the world from militarism unless Germany learns the lesson thoroughly and completely, and they will not save the world or even themselves, by a complete victory over Germany until they, too, have learned and can apply the lesson that militarism has become the deadly enemy of mankind."

The Rooks' Vocabulary. Rooks, declares a writer in the New Statesman, undoubtedly have a considerable vocabulary. Words are uttered when we move suddenly beneath the trees, and other words when a bird intrudes on the precincts of a neighbor's nest; there is a word when the rook sinks down upon the nest, and another word when it flies clear of the rookery and makes for the fields, what danger-signals, what scoldings, what satisfactions, what exultations, what reproaches, what encouragements do we not hear? There is no doubt that the members of the crow family have the fine brains and a notable power of vocalization.
