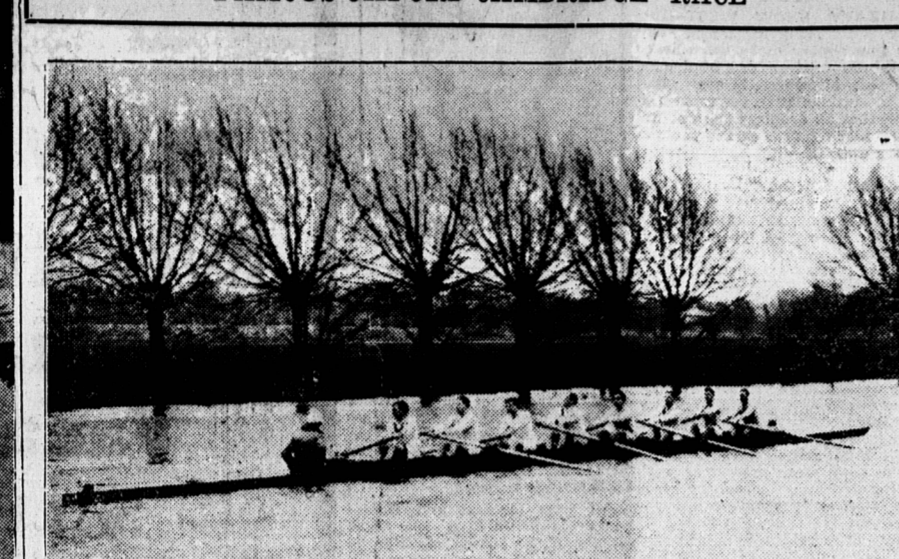

GETTING IN SHAPE FOR THE FAMOUS OXFORD-CAMBRIDGE RACE

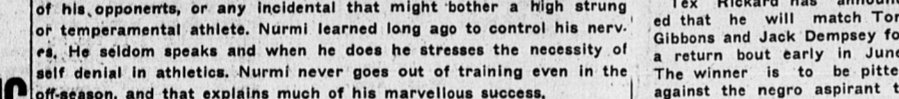

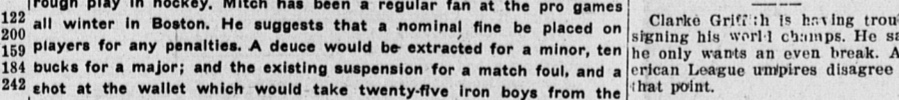

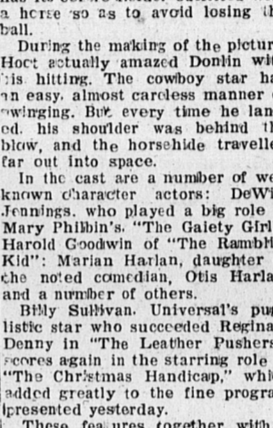
