Atomic Fire Simple As Stove

NEW YORK, Aug. 25 - (AP) - The atomic fire in the graphite ovens at Hanford, Wash., where the plutonium for atomic bombs is made, is as simple as the fire in a stove.

For the stove you need fuel, oxygen and a match. If you could throw away matches and start your stove merely by turning on the oxygen, and extinguish the fire by turning off the oxygen, you would have a counterpart of the atomic fire.

In your home stove you have drafts to regulate the oxygen supply. In the atomic stove you use a bar of beryllium, or maybe a bar of cadmium. Either one regulates the atomic "oxygen" by absorbing neutrons.

The Hanford ovens really are part of the eternal fire that burns everywhere in the universe. They are visible in the stars. These fires are visible in the flames of the atomic bombs. They are not always visible on earth however, since they are usually minute and contained in a very small space. They are minute in the Hanford ovens being only a small fraction of one per cent of the energy in the "atomic" atom that the graphite ovens do not even glow.

Outstanding Catholic Clergy Will Attend Liturgical Week Here

The Liturgical Week will be opened at St. Dunstan's Basilica, Charlottetown on Tuesday next, August 28, and will continue until Saturday. It will be under the patronage of His Excellency, Most Rev. James Doyle, Bishop of Charlottetown.

Following the pattern of the Semaine Liturgique of Belgium and more particularly the National Liturgical Week as developed in the United States, these days will be devoted to liturgical services, conferences and displays.

Two outstanding pioneers of the Liturgical Movement in America are giving conference. Msgr. Reynold Hillenbrand, pastor of Sacred Heart Church, Hubbard Woods, Ill. and Msgr. Martin Hellriegel, pastor of Holy Cross Church, St. Louis, Mo.

The theme of the week "The Integration of Life through the Liturgy" will be developed by recognized leaders from the three Maritime Provinces in a series of fourteen papers. The Liturgical services will be conducted and Homilies delivered by members of the Hierarchy.

The program will open Tuesday evening with Benediction of the Most Blessed Sacrament, the celebrant being the Most Rev. Norbert Robichaud, D.D., Archbishop of Montreal. This will be followed by an address of welcome by Bishop Boyle and by a keynote address.

No person may move to and rent or occupy family quarters in any of these congested areas without a permit from the Administrator of Emergency Shelter.

Before making arrangements to vacate your present home, be sure that you have other accommodation and a permit to occupy it. Applications for permits should be addressed to the Administrator of Emergency Shelter in the area to which you plan to move.

Every person who rents or occupies family quarters in any of these districts contrary to the order, commits an offence and, in addition to other penalties, will be required to vacate the shelter and the district at his own expense.
