THE Pictou Saturday evening Bulletin says: The Presbytery met at New Glasgow and dealt with the call from Summerside to Mr. W. H. Smith. Messrs Archibald and Coffin appeared for the Presbytery of P. E. Island and congregation of Summerside, respectively. The commissioners from Zion Church, Ferrona, Messrs McLean, I. McNaughton, and G. H. McKay urged earnestly that Mr. Smith should remain with them, and gave flattering testimony to his success, and the unanimous desire of the congregation that he might see his way clear to decline the call from Summerside. Mr. Smith having stated that he felt constrained to accept the call, it was agreed to acquiesce in his decision, express sympathy with the congregation of Ferrona, and place him at the disposal of the Presbytery of P. E. Island after the 25th instant.

A MEETING was held at St. Eleanor's Monday evening to make arrangements for the organization of a court of the Independent Order of Foresters. The meeting was a representative one and was very enthusiastic in the matter of taking immediate steps towards organization. Mr. J. M. Clark, H. C. R., Mr. L. U. Fowler, H. Sec., Rev. J. M. Withycombe, Summerside, Geo. D. Brown, Thos. E. Lefurgey, St. Eleanor's, Mr. Pickering of Clifton, and others were present and made excellent speeches, showing the desirability of having a court in the village. The High Secretary dealt very fully with the recent constitutional changes and explained to the entire satisfaction of the audience their necessity, and the additional strength they have given to the organization. On a call for membership being made a sufficient number of names were enrolled to justify the organization of a court, and the meeting adjourned till last night when the members were initiated and officers appointed. The names of the officers will be given tomorrow morning.
