**Special Airplanes For The Tropics**  
 COPENHAGEN, Dec. 7.—A special flying machine will have to be devised for exploring wild tropical countries, said Hans H. Hoyte, pilot of Prof. Mathew Stirling's New Guinea expedition, in an interview published in the Java Bode of Batavia, on the eve of his sailing for Europe.  
 Hoyte, a Dane by birth, was on his way to his family home at Lundby, Denmark, but was stricken with typhoid fever en route and died at Alexandria, Egypt. He had been employed for a number of years with the Jackey Aircraft Co. of Chicago.  
 Violent changes in climatic conditions, such as experienced in New Guinea, Hoyte said, were fatal to any ordinary plane, although his machine had done great service on thirty flights transporting men and material in sometimes very trying circumstances. Finally, he had to leave it behind at one of the bases, with its floats smashed.

**Women Cause Problem For Smokers On Train**  
 CHICAGO, Dec. 7.—Abolition of smoking cars may come about in favor of a car devoted to those who abhor nicotine, according to traffic managers of the Illinois Central railroad, who have been facing a new problem with the introduction of new cars on the electrified suburban lines.  
 "Women crowd into the smoking cars, although few of them smoke in the train. They occupy seats desired by men who want to smoke." A professor at the University of Chicago counted 32 women in a crowded smoking car one day, only one of them smoking. He went back through the train where there were many vacant seats.

**Many Wrecks Result Of Storm**  
 (Canadian Press)  
 HALIFAX, Dec. 7.—The toll of wrecked vessels and damage at sea and on land was rapidly mounting last night as the blizzard which swept the Maritime provinces, with record breaking fury the last twenty-four hours showed little sign of abating. Ten fishing and cargo schooners had piled on the shores of Nova Scotia or New Brunswick and three small steamers were reported wrecked while grave fears were expressed that with the resumption of normal communication greater disasters would be reported. In addition to those disasters reported earlier in the day the fishing schooner Araucana dragged ashore at Lockeport and was likely to be a total loss while the 34 ton steamer Lily Hedge dragged ashore at the same place.  
 The schooner Frances Mason and Daisy Marguerite, broke from their winter moorings at Riverport and crashed on Kraut Point, Lunenburg, and were in hopeless position. The schooner four masted A. P. Davison stranded on Whitehead, near Grand Manan, N. B., and the crew escaped while the vessel became a total loss. Captain Innes Morrissey reported the safety of his crew to the owners at Parrsboro.  
 The schooner Carl Creaser pounded ashore near Lunenburg and was wrecked. No lives had been reported lost although several crews had thrilling escapes in the icy surf. The British Steamer Hullcroft without fuel and with all her wood work exhausted yesterday, was still being battered about off Newfoundland with another Steamer standing by. No late reports had been received. The New York tug Western which grounded, near Shelburne a week ago with a large cargo of liquor, disappeared in today's storm carrying 2,000 cases of loose bottled liquor.

**Sinclair Portfolio Still In Doubt**  
 OTTAWA, Dec. 7.—The new portfolio which Premier King recently stated he would create is now said to be probably that of fisheries, and it is said that Hon. J. E. Sinclair, (Liberal Queen's P. E. I.) will be the first minister to assume the post. Premier King has announced that the portfolio probably would go to Prince Edward Island. Mr. Sinclair was a member without portfolio in last Liberal cabinet. The Department of Fisheries now is joined to the Dept. of Marine of which Hon. P. J. A. Carlin is minister. On the other hand it is stated that the new portfolio may be that of Colonization which now is joined to Immigration under Hon. Robt. Forke. It Colonization should be made a separate department, it is not known whether Mr. Sinclair would be willing to accept.
