Hawkesbury Journal. The trim schooner Empress, 392 tons owned by George Whitman, Montague, P.E.I., is on our Marine Railway, undergoing extensive repairs sufficient to warrant her being released.

Happy-go-Lucky, Allen, from Montague to Sydney; Edward Grozier, Bennett, from Charlottetown to Sydney; Vandala, Dicks, from Georgetown to Burgeo, Nfld; Circaison, Skinner, from Charlottetown to Sydney; Carrie, Boudreau, from Charlottetown to Sydney.

The schooner Myosotis has arrived in Arichat, N. S., with a cargo of potatoes. An Arichat despatch says: Lawrence Keating, of Arichat, a seaman on board the schooner Myosotis, Cap. Boudrot, from Charlottetown, fell from the bowsprit when coming through the Strait last evening, and was drowned. Every effort was made to save him but without avail.

The Northern Whig of Belfast, Ireland, says:—'An important link with the past has been snapped by the death of Lady Harland, widow of the late Sir Edward Harland Bart., founder of the world-famed shipbuilding concern of the Queen's Island, Ex-Mayor of the city, and M. P. for its North Division.'
