N.Y. Stocks In Slow Decline
NEW YORK, June 9 —(AP)—A slow-moving decline in the stock market today carried many leaders down fractions to around 2 points.
Steels, motors, nonferrous metals and rails were among the principal losers, although here and there favored issues succeeded in resisting the move.
Commission houses reported buying enthusiasm was chilled by nervousness over labor disruptions and foreign situations, while the delay in presidential action on the tax bill added another uncertain element to the picture. Earnings and dividends, along with hopes for a summer recovery, aided some issues.
American Telephone was prominent on the downside, closing off 2 points at 182. U. S. Steel at 64 1-2 was off 5-8. Goodyear was down 1 at 42. Kennecott 7-8 at 12 1-8. General Motors 1-2 at 55 1-2. Others lower included Decca Records, Republic Steel, Chrysler, Pennsylvania Railroad, Norfolk and Western Union Pacific, Pullman and Ohio, International Harvester, Anaconda, International Nickel, Oliver Corp., Trans Continental and Western Air, and Philip Morris.
Texas Pacific Land Trust climbed 1 3-8 to a new 1947 high of 23 1-2. Pacific Telephone, down sharply on a dividend reduction last Friday, recovered 3 3-4 points to 100. Also ahead was South Porto Rico Sugar, C. C. Cola, American, Can. Sears, C. C. Cuck, Goodrich and Du Pont. New York and Harlem jumped to 230.
