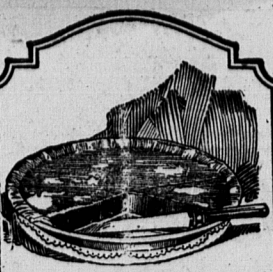

COCOA PIE

4 tablespoons Cowan Cocoa
3 tablespoons cornstarch or 1/2 cup flour
1 1/2 cups hot milk
1 tablespoon butter
2 eggs
1/4 teaspoon salt
1 teaspoon vanilla

- Heat milk.
- Mix cornstarch, sugar, salt and cocoa.
- Add gradually to hot milk.
- Cook over hot water 45 minutes.
- Beat egg yolks slightly, add and cook a few minutes longer.
- Fill baked crust cover with meringue made of beaten whites and two table-spoons icing sugar.
- Brown in oven.
