OUT-SOARING THE BIRDS.

When the aeroplane was first made and tested in successful flight it was not believed that the flying men by this means could reach any very considerable height.

power were used because of the necessary limitations as to weight. The aeroplane must support its own weight, which is necessarily considerable, and also the weight of the man who guides it, the engine that propels it and the fuel to operate the engine.

The birds have wonderful powers of flight yet but few of them ever attain an altitude of even half a mile above the earth. The soaring hawk, the eagle and the condor are among the exceptions.

Men are already out-soaring most of the birds in altitude but are now close competitors with the swiftest of them in speed. In the Belmont Park competition a flight of over 62 miles was made in 61 minutes.

Again, in the first attempts at flight engines of comparatively small

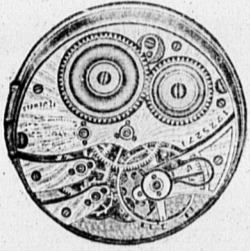

Late advices from New York tell of the great strike of express men there, which interferes seriously with the fish trade. The transportation is delayed and in consequence the fish arrive in bad order.

The reciprocity negotiations will open in Ottawa tomorrow. Messrs Pepper and Hoyt, who took part in the trade negotiations of last spring, with Mr. Foster, the U. S. Consul General, will represent the United States Government, and will confer with Hon. Messrs Fielding and Paterson as representatives of Canada.

The report of L. W. Watson, Agent of the Children's Aid Society for the past year gives in some detail the work so far done. Mr. Watson was appointed on 26th May last and has given his attention to a number of cases of destitution and neglect, which but for the institution of the C. A. S. would probably have not received any special attention.

SYDNEY, Oct. 31.—While in Sydney Rev. T. Albert Moore, general secretary of the Lord's Day Alliance visited the steel plant and was pleased to find that a great deal of the Sunday work had been done away with. AMERICAN TARIFF EXPERTS HARD AT WORK.

WASHINGTON, Oct. 31.—The possibilities for reciprocity with Canada have progressed to the point where the Tariff Board is about to take up some of the schedules of the present law which would be affected. The chemical schedule upon which a start was made several weeks ago, will be allowed to wait tentatively at least, and it is said to be not unlikely that an investigation of the lumber schedule which would be one of the principal factors in the reciprocity arrangement, will take its place.

Experts who have been working on the pulp-wood and paper schedule in which the Canadian arrangements would also be concerned. Are also making progress beyond the expectations of the Board. Several large paper companies have volunteered to furnish important information which at one time it was doubtful if the Board could obtain.

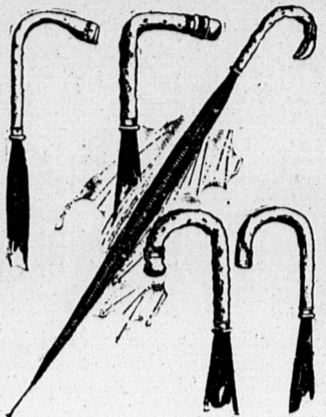
