The latest news, first of all.

On Monday night last the dwelling house of Charles R. Burke, Elmisdale was burned to ashes with most of the contents.

Captain Wm Richards, Bideford, left yesterday morning for Montreal to be present at the funeral of his son-in-law, Wm McLea Walbank, who died on Monday last.

The marriage took place at West Medford, Mass. on Nov 23rd of Albert D. Brehaut, formerly of Summerside and Miss Henrietta R. Beaton of West Newton, Mass.

Owing to the snow storm and gale the Empress did not leave Point Du Chene last night at the usual hour. The evening mail trains east and west left Summerside shortly before 8 o'clock. The Empress will arrive in the early morning.

In Summerside yesterday dealers were paying twenty-five cents a dozen for eggs; eight dollars and fifty cents a ton for loose hay four dollars and fifty cents for straw; twenty-five per bushel for potatoes, forty to forty-one cents per bus for oats and eight and eight and three quarter cents per lb for pork.

Mrs J.S. Wilson, Coleman, Alta, accompanied by her little daughter, a man, who has been visiting her mother, Mrs James Orr, at her old home in French River, and other friends in different parts of the Province, for the past few months, left by the Empress yesterday on return to her home.

A letter has been received by the Secretary of the Board of Trade, Summerside, from Hon L. F. Bourdeur, Minister of Marine and Fisheries, stating that instructions have been given to have a motor placed on the Summerside-Tarleton route, the service to begin when the Empress is withdrawn from Summerside.

Alberton dealers are paying thirty seven cents a bus for white oats and thirty-eight cents for black; twenty-one cents a dozen for eggs, twenty-one cents a pound for butter; nineteen cents a bus for potatoes; ten cents a lb for hides; eight to eight and three-quarter cents a lb for pork; ten cents for turnips and eight dollars a ton for loose hay.

The Supreme Court opened in Summerside yesterday, His Lordship Chief Justice Sullivan presiding. The docket is quite a large one and includes five criminal cases. There are present from Charlottetown, Attorney-General Hazard, J. J. Johnstone, W. S. Stewart, W. E. Bentley, W. A. O. Morson, Prothonotary, George Tweedy, Alberton, besides the legal fraternity of Summerside.

POLITICAL ATMOSPHERE OF CUBA MORE OBSCURE

The re-established republic is scarcely nine months old, and already rumors have become persistent that some way is being sought to work the retirement of President Gomez, either by perbution or compulsion, and to place Vice President Zayas at the head of the nation. When General Gomez received the post of chief magistrate from Governor Magoon, the followers of Vice President Zayas stood shoulder to shoulder with those of the President in the determination to give the new administration a fair trial.
