WINNIPEGERS ARGUE ABOUT GIRL CADETS

WINNIPEG, Feb. 27.—(CP)—Winnipeggers are divided in their opinions on the advisability of having a girl cadet corps, whose members would be trained in military drill, but it goes against their better judgment. "Those against the corps don't like it because it is a 'hardship' idea. I think it's something like the Germans, of course we don't want that, but it's good training."

Winnipeggers Argue About Girl Cadets

The principal of a school which has a girl cadet corps is in favor of the idea. "The girls department and everything is so much improved," she said. "The Greater Winnipeg area alone had 15 schools which include girls in their cadet program. Some teachers are being assisted by members of the Canadian Women's Army Corps in organizing training for the girls of girl cadets. It is unauthorized and no government grant is allotted to it, though girls cadets are eligible to fire in the Dominion of Canada Rifle Association competitions."
