 CHICAGO, Sept. 30 — Despite late estimates that export purchases of United States wheat today totalled 1,500,000 bushels, Chicago prices declined as dealings drew to an end.
 Late selling of wheat futures in Chicago was regarded as against purchases at Minneapolis and Kansas City. Agreements trading in futures, however, was not large.
 At the close, wheat was 3-4 to 2 cents under yesterday's finish. Dec. 1-2 to 5-8, May 1-2 to 1-4 down, Oct. 7-12, Dec. 63 1-8 to 1-4, and oats unchanged at 1-10.

FINANCIAL NEWS BRIEFS

NEW YORK, Sept. 30—London opened steady and at 2 p. m. New York stock, according to Dow Jones was higher than the New York close of yesterday. The Paris bourse is also better. This is rather encouraging news in view of the fact that new paper headlines today are not favorable. Judging from the newspaper reports, England is taking a firm stand concerning Italy's position in Spain. A campaign against Japanese goods is also growing in England. Although the news today is not especially good, yesterday's market action was comparatively well and we look for an irregular firm market today. Indications are growing that a base is being made for a better market during October, with the possibility that the Dow Jones industrial average will carry back to around 170.

NEW YORK, Sept. 30—Whether the near party engineered yesterday's break in our stock on the European market or not, leaders broke sharply but again sharp shooting bears were forced to cover at advancing prices and close showed a great many more

ups than downs with leaders about where they had been. Second and third rail stocks had suffered very seriously in previous market, but not only showed real resiliency in most cases in Tuesday's market but failed to give much ground yesterday showing real strength at the close. Aeroplane issues and oils are cases in point. Douglas, United Aircraft and Boeing, together with Texas Corp., Standards of N. J. and California, Pure, Phillips, Seaboard, Ohio, Amerada, Skelly among the oils show real underlying strength and we think may be expected to do much better. Same with the farm implement group. Motors are also in demand on the weak places with General Motors and Chrysler, Hudson and Nash, White, Packard and Studebaker like'y will stocks for the fall with the new models coming out and the general hurrah that is made at that time. Despite the moderate slowing down of business here and there, the outlook seems to us nothing like as bad as it seems when the breaks occur. Steel almost back to its low for the whole move and then up again.

Produce Prices

MONTREAL, Sept. 30 — (CP)—Butter continued higher on Montreal open produce markets today with eggs and potatoes holding about even.

Graded egg shipments in carlots or less were quoted at 37 cents a dozen for grade A-large, 35 for A-medium, 30 for A-pulleys, 25 to 26 for B-large and 20 to 21 for C.

Butter was quoted at 27 cents a pound for carlots or less of No. 1 while lots to retailers were 28 1-2 for solids and 29 for prints.

Cheese was quoted at 14 1-8 to 1-4 cents a pound for Ontario whites with coloreds at 14 1-2 to 5-8. Quebec whites sold at 13 3-4 with coloreds at 13 7-8.

MINING

TORONTO, Sept. 30 — Mining shares kept the recovery torch alight on the Toronto exchange today and generally closed near the day's peak. Volume was highest for the week.

Led by Dome, senior golds continued to climb. Dome traded more than 3,000 shares and closed 1 5-8 higher at 43 5-8. McIntyre added more than a point and Buffalo Ankerite, Hollinger, Lake Shore, Macassa, Little Long, Lac and Wright-Hargreaves were higher.

Anglo-Huronian and Read Athier were up 55 and 20 cents respectively at 4.75 and 3.40.

Oil stocks held more than usual interest. Royalite improved 2 1-2 to 36 and gains up to 9 cents came out for Dalhousie, Okalta, Brown, Calmont, Home, Calgary and Edmonton and Foundation.

Noranda, Sudbury Basin, Ventures, Coast Copper and Hudson Bay were in fair demand.

Bigdod and Moneta were most active of the cheaper golds and moved up 3 and 7 cents respectively.

Additions of 5 to 15 cents were chalked up on Beattie, Central Patricia, Hard Rock, Kerr Addison, Madson, Preston, Prospectors' Airways, Stadacona and Sullivan.

Kirkland Lake softened 4 and Chromium, Lagun and Coniarum were down.

Eldorado and Mining Corporation netted fair gains in the dull silver group.

NEW YORK, Sept. 30 — (AP)—The French franc bolstered its position in terms of the United States dollar today as cables from abroad rumored cabinet changes in an effort to strengthen the French monetary situation.

The franc gained 00 1-2 of a cent at 3.42 1-2. The pound sterling gained 1-16 of a cent at 4.95 1-8. Unchanged were the Holland guilder and the Swiss franc. The Canadian dollar was also unchanged at par.
