The Alaskan boundary dispute relates to the actual boundary between British Columbia and Alaska. The Lord British Commissioners are Lord Chief Justice Alverstone of England, and Sir Louis Jetté, Retired Judge of the Supreme Court of Quebec, and Chief Justice Armour of Ontario.

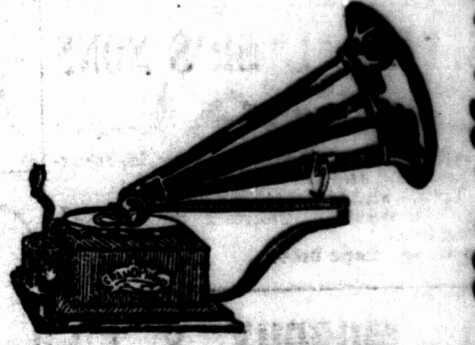
