### LONDON GIRLS GREAT SWIMMERS

LONDON, Dec. 1.—For the first time for 15 years the girls of London have showed a greater aptitude than boys in learning to swim. This is recorded in a report to London County Council Education Committee.

The percentage of girls actually taught to swim has risen from 36 to 40 in the last year, and the percentage of boys has decreased from 36 to 35.

During the year 156,843 children had lessons in swimming, and 40,272 had learnt to swim by the end of the year.
