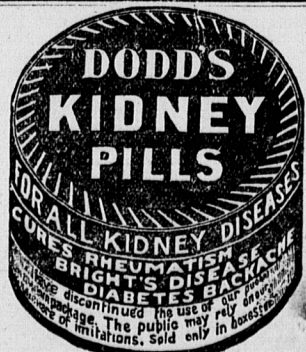

### NEW WAX GROUPS AT THE EDEN MUSEUM.

NEW YORK, April 4.—The management of the Eden Museum, of New York City, is continually arranging for new wax figures and groups which will be instructive as well as of general interest. A large corps of artists are continually at work so that new figures or groups are placed on exhibition almost daily. During the past week there had been placed on exhibition an excellent wax representation of Rear-Admiral C. S. Sperry, who was in charge of the war fleet which has just successfully circled the world. Another new group that will attract much attention has been placed in the Crypt, and is called "The Siberian Boundary Post." It represents the dividing line between Russia and Siberia, where exiles from Russia say farewell to the world, and enter the land of hardships. Large brick and cement columns show the dividing line between these two countries. It is by these posts that the last farewells are said to families and relatives. In this group a number of exiles are taking their sorrowful and agonizing parting before entering the land of permanent exile. Altogether, eighteen figures make up the group, and the costumes as well as the surroundings are accurately shown. Many new moving pictures have been received and are shown hourly during the afternoon and evening. The afternoon and evening concerts by Professor Kapussy and his new Hungarian orchestra will be continued and will be of special interest to lovers of classical music.

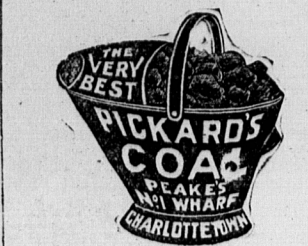

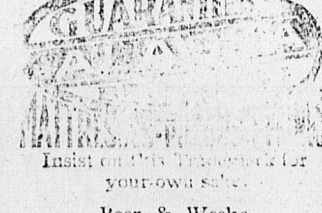
