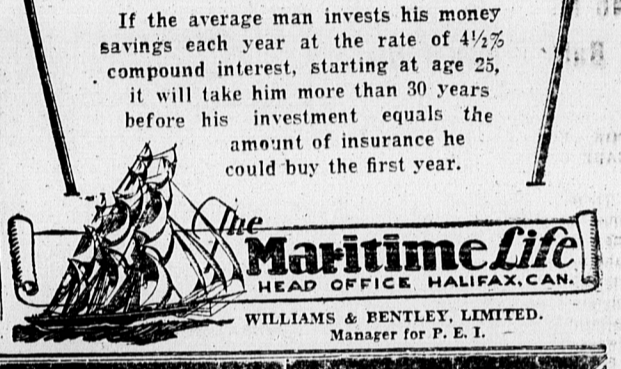
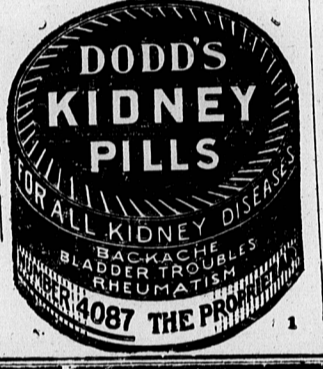
Late Market News

(Canadian Press) MONTREAL, Que., Oct. 17.—A firm tone was displayed today on the dairy and produce markets here. The butter market was slightly higher with eastern townships Number One pasteurized creamy butter in cartons quoted at 29 to 29 1/2 cents a pound. Solids were 32 to 33 cents a pound and prints 33 to 34 cents a pound. Receipts were 768 boxes. The cheese market was firm, with Quebec's quoted at 14 3/8 to 14 1/2 cents a pound and Ontario's at 15 3/8 cents a pound. Receipts were 3,880 boxes. A stronger feeling was displayed on the egg market today. Carlot prices were 45 cents, firsts 36 to 37 and seconds 27 to 28 cents. Receipts totalled 328 cases. The potato market was unchanged with New Brunswick green mountains at \$1.05 and cobbler at 95 cents to \$1 per eighty pound bag.
