BOOTHS TO BE RECONCILED.

Report That the Breach in the Salvation Army Will Soon Be Healed.

CLEVELAND, O., June 3.—The says: I. D. Hazard, financial secretary of the Salvation Army, is authority for the statement that secret negotiations are being carried on, looking to a reconciliation between General William Booth and his son, Ballington. Father and son have been estranged for five years, the son having in the meantime organized the Volunteers of America.

The cause of the estrangement, according to Mr. Hazard, was the refusal of Ballington Booth to submit to the order of transfer from the United States to Canada. If the reconciliation be effected, it will mean Ballington's return to the Salvation Army and probably result in the abolishment of the Volunteers of America and its affiliation with the Salvation Army.

Sunday School Convention at Bridgetown.

Secy. Tres.—W. E. Leard, Rev. H. Pierce and Joseph Cheffey were added to the officers to constitute the Executive.

The Association is intended to embrace the Schools in Lots 38, 39, 40, 41, 42, 54, 55 and 56.

EVENING SESSION.

This Session was opened by singing by the Choir and prayer by J. B. McLure. The President occupied the chair and gave some good remarks on the great benefit derived from attendance at Sunday School.

A paper was then read by Mrs. W. E. Leard bearing on the duties of the S. School Teacher.

The Secy. and Treas. were called on and gave a report of the work done at the afternoon session.

The Rev. G. P. Raymond was the next speaker and gave a very inspiring and instructive address. He spoke very effectively on Normal Work in our schools.

The Question Box was then opened and excellent attention was paid while Mr. Raymond very cleverly answered the practical questions.

Appropriate music was rendered by a Union Choir consisting of singers from the different churches of Dundas. Miss Annie McDonald presided at the organ.

A hearty vote of thanks was tendered to the Field Secretary.

The Convention adjourned to meet on Aug. 27th, at a place to be selected by the Executive.

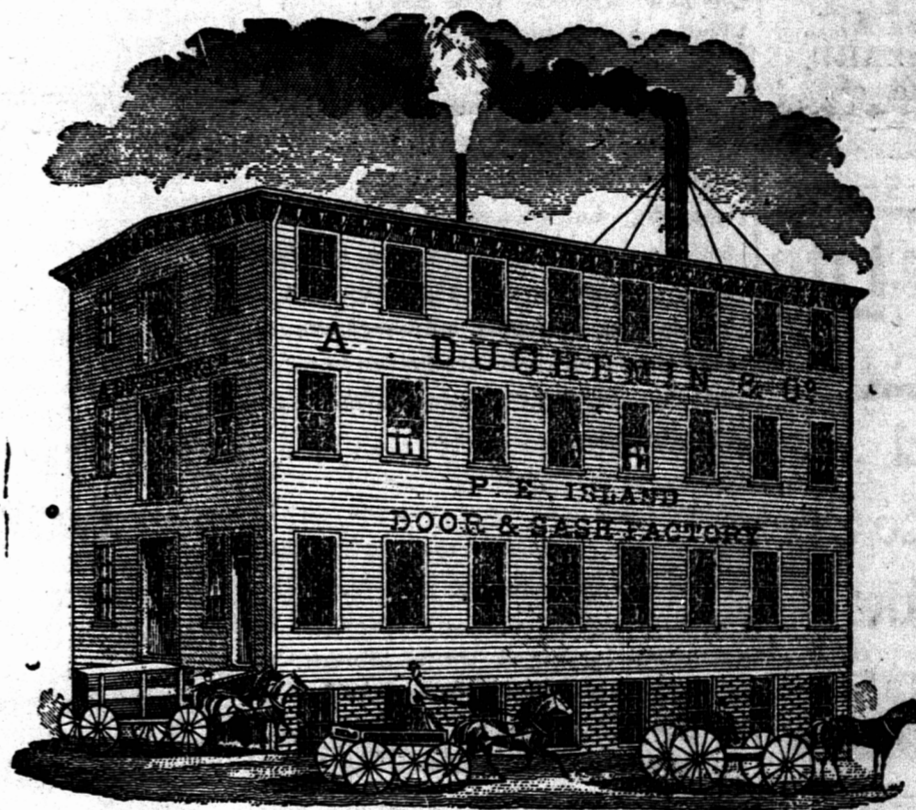

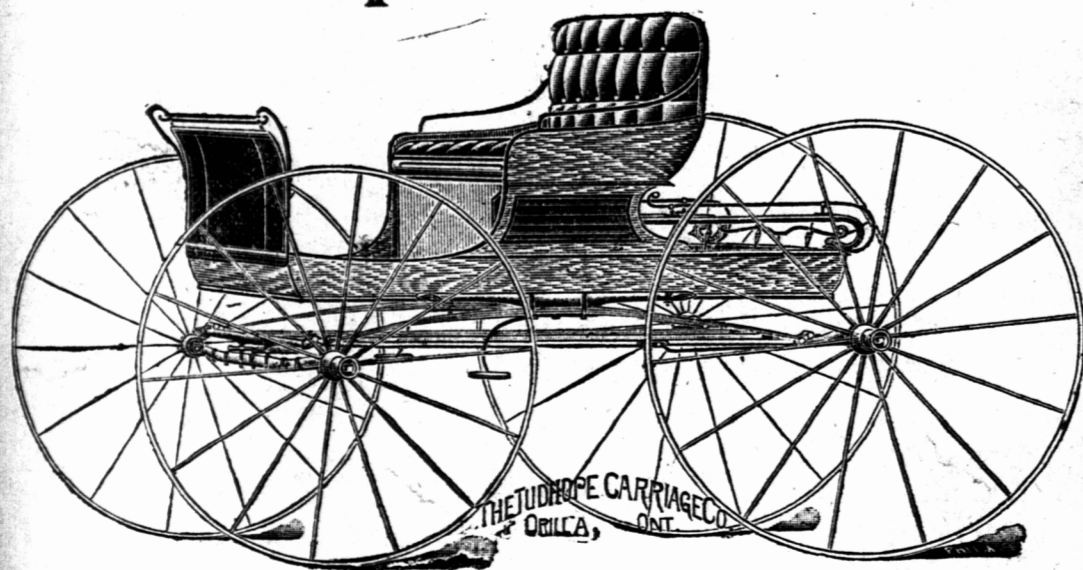

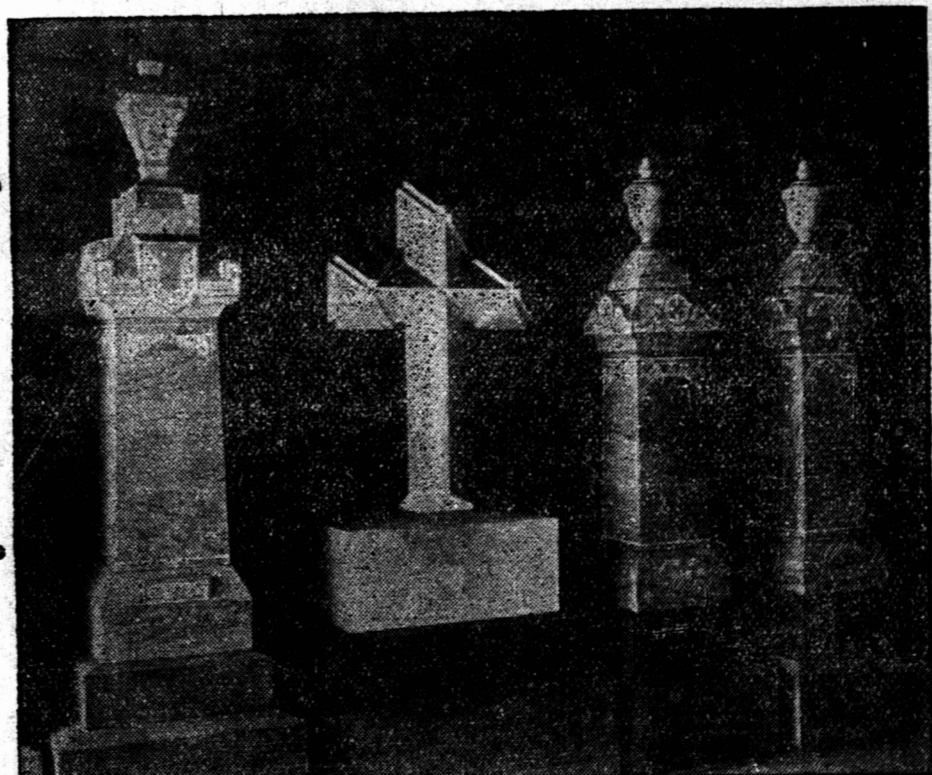
