OPPOSED TO IMMIGRANTS FROM CENTRAL EUROPE

WINNIPEG, May 2.—At a full meeting of the western directors of the Western Colonization Association held here, it was determined that the kind of settlers to be brought into western Canada should for the most part come from the British Isles and the United States. It was also thought good sense might be obtained from Scandinavia and from Belgium and France. The board was, however, unanimous that no immigrants should be allowed into this country from central or southern Europe under any conditions.

SYDNEY, May 2.—A general wage cut of from eight to ten per cent was put into effect by the C. B. Electric Co., which operates the Interurban Tram Lines of Island.

ICE BREAKER HAZEN HAS BEEN LOCATED

After an absence of years, during which she was more or less of a war mystery, the world's greatest ice breaker, the John D. Hazen built in Canada, has been found and local reports are to the effect that she is now anchored at Cherbourg, France. The mammoth ice breaker was sold during the war to the Imperial Government of Russia. She was last heard of as being instrumental in keeping Archangel and White Sea ports open during the time of the big Russian offensive. The lack of the John D. Hazen, which was originally designed for the St. Lawrence, had been keenly felt in the meantime. Shortly after the armistice inquiries were sent out as to the whereabouts of the ice breaker but no trace could be found of her. It was presumed that she had been taken over by the Bolsheviks or sunk by the same people. The present report revives the supposition that Canada will re-purchase the ice-breaker for the St. Lawrence. With the assistance of other ice-breakers which the Government intends to build, it is predicted that St. Lawrence shipping and Canada generally will benefit very largely in the longer shipping season.

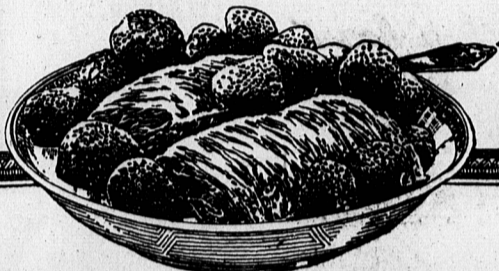

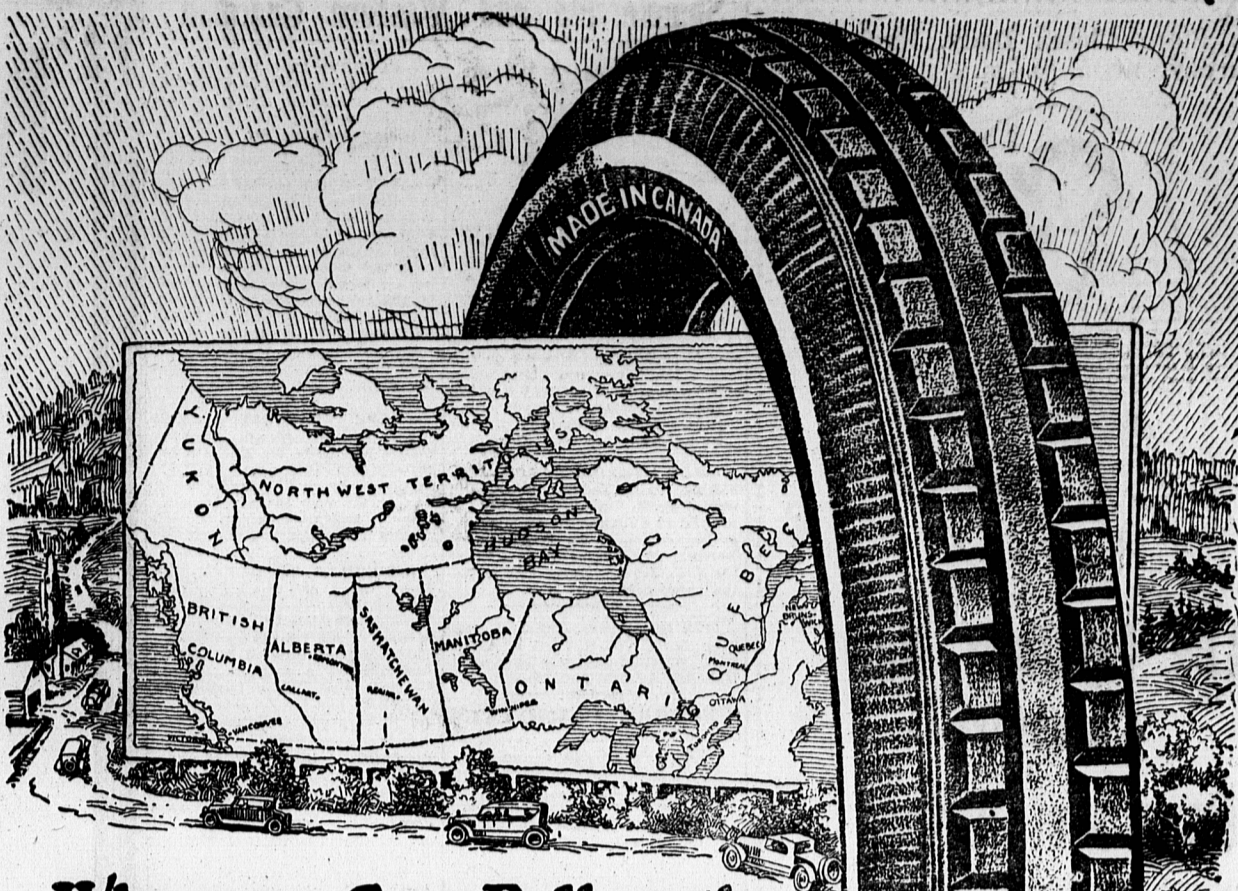

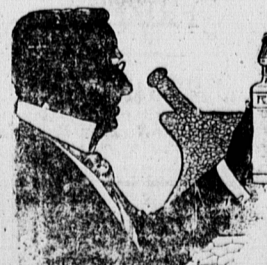
